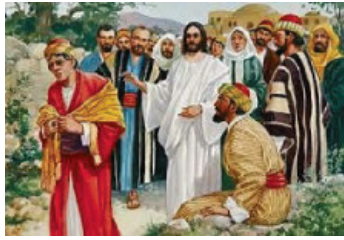

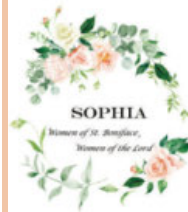

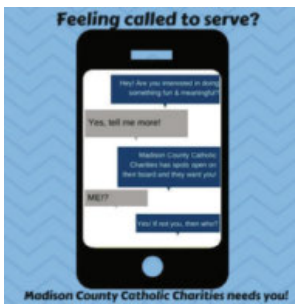


SOPHIA—NEW Women's Group

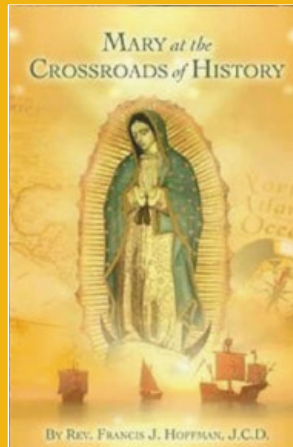

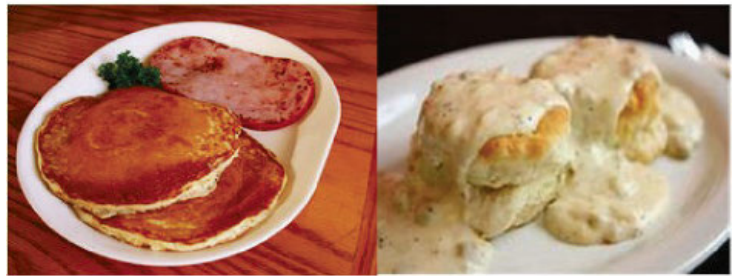
