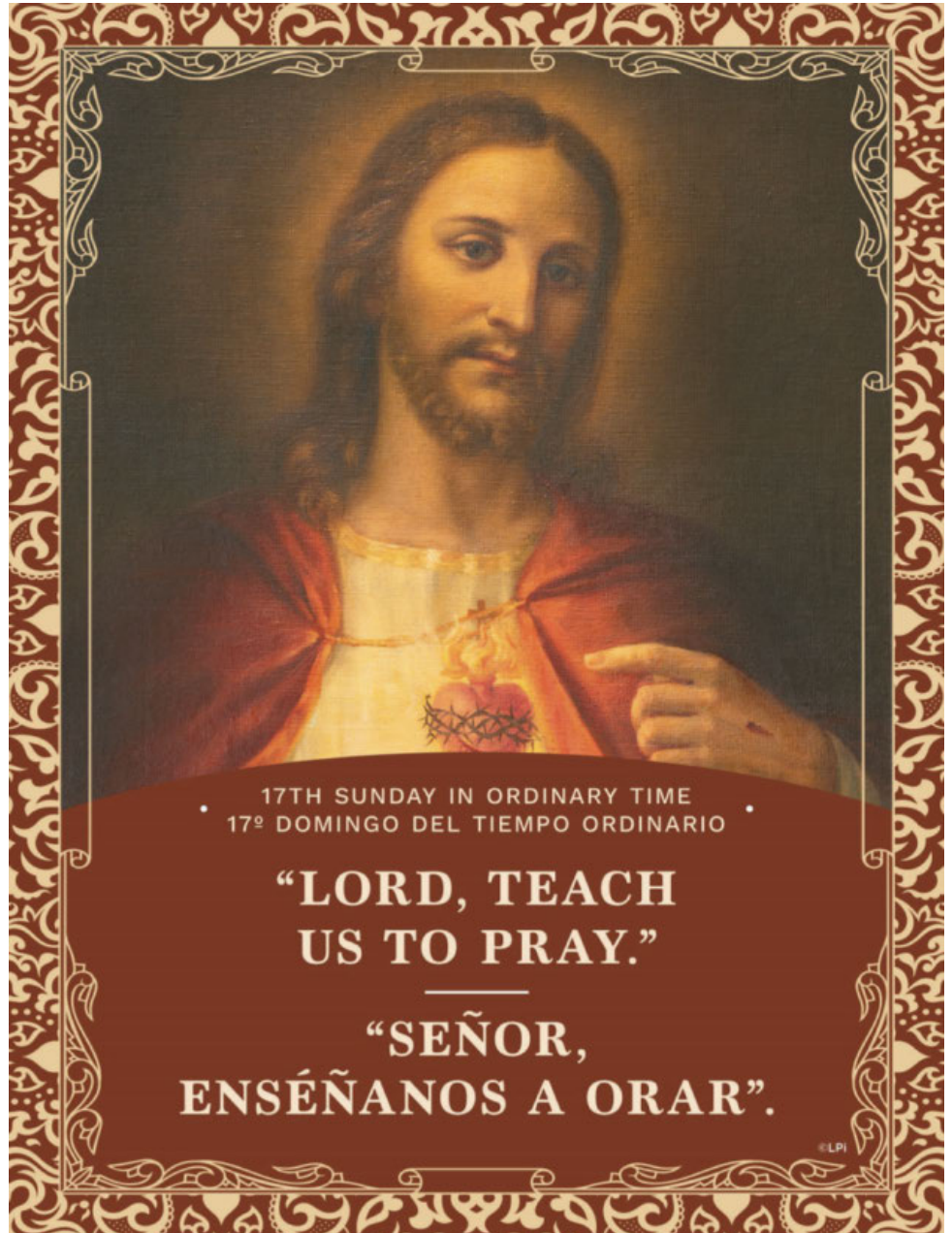

WEEKLY NOTE

Establishing the Parish: Sacrifices Honoring Our Blessed Mother

To meet the needs of the immigrants flooding the Bucktown area of Chicago, the pastor of St. Stanislaus Kostka, Fr. Vincent Barzynski CR, petitioned Archbishop Patrick Feehan to make a new parish between St. Stanislaus Kostka and St. Hedwig. So the Archbishop established St. Mary of the Angels on November 28, 1898. Fr. Andrzej Spetz CR and Fr. Franciszek

(Francis) Gordon CR found a two-city block site between Paulina and Wood, and between Bloomingdale and Clybourn Place (renamed Cortland Avenue in 1913). The site was purchased for \$60,000 (the agent donated \$500 of his \$1,500 commission for the new church). One block was subdivided for parishioners' homes while the other became the site of the parish.

Fr. Francis Gordon CR

At age 39, Fr. Francis Gordon became the first pastor of the new parish. Fr. Gordon was a great figure in Chicago heading the Polish newspaper, *Dziennik Chicagowski*, and founding the *Polish Alma Mater* that served more than 10,000 youths.

Faithful to Catholic teaching and dedicated to Polish immigrants, Fr. Gordon formed a new parish council that first met on February 12, 1899. The members included Franciszek Osiński, Franciszek Roszkowski, Michał Borkowicz, Michał Rafflewski, Jakób Klinger, and Józef Wróblewski, Wojciech (or Adalbert) Przybylski, Jan Kaminski, Ignacy Ignatowski, Michał Huntowski, Wawrzyniec (Lawrence) Wachowski, and Piotr Bykowski. A week after its formation the council unanimously agreed on the architect's tentative blueprints for the church.

They broke ground for the church building on April 21, 1899 and Fr. Jan Kasprzycki CR, Superior Resurrectionists in Chicago, blessed the cornerstone on July 2. The three-story brick building was built for \$65,000 and designed in the Polish Renaissance style by Henry J. Schlacks—Schlacks became University of Notre Dame's first Director of the School of Architecture. On December 10, 1899, Archbishop Feehan dedicated the church with Chicago's mayor, Carter Harrison, Jr., and a crowd of 20,000 in attendance.

St. Mary of the Angels was built with love, sacrifice, and nickels and dimes; it was built in love and honor of Our Blessed Mother. These sacrifices were made both by the priests and parish staff, but above all by the faithful parishioners who were moved by love to make these sacrifices for their families and their Mother.

Fr. Gordon celebrated the first Mass at St. Mary of the Angels church on December 11, 1899, the day after its dedication. In 1900 a church organ was installed and a year later the church bells—cast in Troy, New York—were acquired for \$4,000. A special bell tower was built in the schoolyard just north of the church. The bells rang out for the first time on August 1, 1901 to summon the faithful to honor of the Patroness of the parish.

The one building held everything. The upper floor church seated 924 for Mass while the middle floor school, which began instruction in 1900, was divided into twelve classrooms for the school. The lower floor had meeting rooms and an auditorium with a balcony opposite the stage—it even had fans to blow air over blocks of ice for air conditioning. The priests resided on the west end and the convent—for the four Sisters of the Congregation of the Resurrection (Sisters Anna Strzelecka, Casimira Szydzik, Sophie Podworska, and Mathilda Surej) who arrived from Rome on February 15, 1900—was in the attic.



Fr. Gordon left St. Mary of the Angels briefly to become pastor of St. Stanislaus Kostka in 1906, the mother parish for the Polish people in Chicago. But Fr. Gordon's assignment there was brief and returned to St. Mary of the Angels as pastor three years later.

In 1905 the Resurrectionist Sisters built their novitiate at 1849 N. Hermitage (across from the current church; it was sold by the sisters and now houses condominiums).

The bishops of Chicago established other Polish churches as immigrants continued to pour into Chicago: Holy Innocents (1905), St. Wenceslaus (1912), St. Helen (1913), St. Ladislaus and St. James (1914), St. Constance (1916), St. Thecla (1925), St. Fidelis (1926)—not to mention many other parishes on Chicago's south and west side.

Establecimiento de la Parroquia: Sacrificios en Honor a Nuestra Santísima Madre

Para satisfacer las necesidades de la gran cantidad de inmigrantes en el área de Bucktown en Chicago, el párroco de San Estanislao Kostka, el Padre Vincent Barzynski CR, solicitó al Arzobispo Patrick Feehan que hiciera una nueva parroquia entre San Estanislao Kostka y Santa Eduvigis. Así que el Arzobispo estableció Santa María de los Ángeles el 28 de noviembre de 1898. El Padre Andrzej Spetz CR y el Padre Franciszek (Francis) Gordon CR, encontraron un sitio de dos manzanas entre Paulina y Wood, y entre Bloomingdale y Clybourn Place (renombrado como Cortland Avenue en 1913). El sitio fue comprado por \$60,000 (el agente donó \$500 de su comisión de \$1,500 para la nueva iglesia). Una manzana fue subdividida para casas de los feligreses, mientras que la otra se convirtió en el sitio de la parroquia.

Padre Francis Gordon CR

A la edad de 39 años, el Padre Francis Gordon se convirtió en el primer párroco de la nueva parroquia. El Padre Gordon fue una gran figura en Chicago al frente del periódico polaco *Dziennik Chicagoski*, y fundó el *Alma Mater polaca* que atendía a más de 10.000 jóvenes.

Fiel a la enseñanza católica y dedicado a los inmigrantes polacos, el Padre Gordon formó un nuevo consejo parroquial que se reunió por primera vez el 12 de febrero de 1899. Entre sus miembros se encontraban Franciszek Osinski, Franciszek Roszkowski, Michał Borkowicz, Michał Rafflewski, Jakób Klinger y Józef Wróblewski, Wojciech (o Adalbert) Przybylski, Jan Kaminski, Ignacy Ignatowski, Michał Huntowski, Wawrzyniec (Lawrence) Wachowski y Piotr Bykowski. Una semana después de su formación, el consejo acordó por unanimidad los planos tentativos del arquitecto para la iglesia.

Comenzaron la construcción de la iglesia el 21 de abril de 1899 y el Padre Jan Kasprzycki CR, Superior Resurreccionista en Chicago, bendijo la piedra angular el 2 de julio. El edificio de ladrillo de tres pisos fue construido por \$ 65,000 y diseñado en el estilo renacentista polaco por Henry J. Schlacks, quien se convirtió en el primer Director de la Escuela de Arquitectura de la Universidad de Notre Dame. El 10 de diciembre de 1899, el arzobispo Feehan dedicó la iglesia con el alcalde de Chicago, Carter Harrison, Jr., y una multitud de 20.000 asistentes.



Santa María de los Ángeles fue construida con amor, sacrificio y monedas de cinco y diez centavos; fue construido en amor y honor a Nuestra Santísima Madre. Estos sacrificios fueron realizados tanto por los sacerdotes como por el personal de la parroquia, pero sobre todo por los fieles feligreses que fueron movidos por el amor a hacer estos sacrificios por sus familias y por su Madre.

El Padre Gordon celebró la primera Misa en la iglesia de Santa María de los Ángeles el 11 de diciembre de 1899, el día después de su dedicación. En 1900 se instaló un órgano y un año más tarde las campanas de la iglesia, fundidas en Troy, Nueva York, fueron adquiridas por 4.000 dólares. Se construyó un campanario especial en el patio de la escuela, justo al norte de la iglesia. Las campanas repicaron por primera vez el 1 de agosto de 1901 para convocar a los fieles a honrar a la Patrona de la parroquia.

Un solo edificio lo contenía todo. La iglesia en el piso superior tenía capacidad para 924 personas para la Misa, mientras que la escuela en el piso de enmedio —que comenzó a impartir clases en 1900— se dividió en doce aulas para la escuela. El piso inferior tenía salas de reuniones y un auditorio con un balcón frente al escenario, incluso tenía ventiladores para soplar aire sobre bloques de hielo para aire acondicionado. Los sacerdotes residían en el extremo oeste y el convento, pues las cuatro hermanas de la Congregación de la Resurrección (las hermanas Anna Strzelecka, Casimira Szydzik, Sophie Podworska y Mathilda Surej) que llegaron de Roma el 15 de febrero de 1900, estaban en el ático.

El Padre Gordon dejó Santa María de los Ángeles brevemente para convertirse en párroco de San Estanislao Kostka en 1906, la parroquia madre del pueblo polaco en Chicago. Pero la asignación del Padre Gordon allí fue breve, y regresó a Santa María de los Ángeles como párroco tres años después.

En 1905 las Hermanas Resurreccionistas construyeron su noviciado en 1849 N. Hermitage (frente a la iglesia actual; fue vendida por las hermanas y ahora alberga condominios).

Los obispos de Chicago establecieron otras iglesias polacas a medida que los inmigrantes continuaban llegando a Chicago: Santos Inocentes (1905), San Wenceslao (1912), Santa Elena (1913), San Ladislao y Santiago (1914), Santa Constanza (1916), Santa Tecla (1925), San Fidel (1926), sin mencionar muchas otras parroquias en el lado sur y oeste de Chicago.

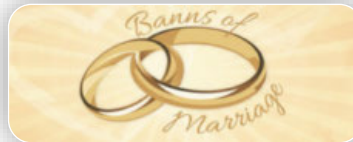


ADULTS CONFIRMATION CLASSES
