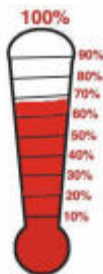
### Bishop's Appeal 2019

The Bishop's Appeal reaches out and impacts the lives of thousands of people every year. Here are some interesting facts to illustrate how the Diocese inspires disciples, and how the Bishop's Appeal is making a difference in the lives of all of us:

54 Catholic schools shared our faith (48 elementary, 6 high school); 156 Parishes celebrated their liturgies throughout the year; 885 Couples were joined in marriage; 2,931 Members of our Diocese passed away; 2,444 Adults and young people were confirmed in their faith; 2,621 Children and adults received Jesus through First Communion; 2,612 Infants and adults joined our parish communities through Baptism; 9,175 Students participated in Catholic Schools; 18,080 Students took part in Religious Education classes; 295,377 Catholics worshiped in Diocesan parishes.

In each of these areas the Bishop's Appeal impacts the ministries that inspire disciples.

Our goal for 2019 is \$32,588. To date 95 people have responded, contributing \$21,957. We have 13 Crozier members so far.

### "How Am I Doing?"

Last week at Alpha, one discussion question was, "If you could ask God one question, what would it be?" The next day someone told us they would ask God, "How am I doing?"

This is possibly the most important question that we could ever ask God! Reflection on our hereafter should be very near to us. It's easy to forget that every day, through our actions or inaction, we are choosing our eternal destiny. One theologian, Fr. John Hardon, refers to our short time on earth as *our time of probation*. It's our "wilderness trial" en route to the land of Heaven. It's our opportunity to choose God – or not chose God. All our choices are made here on earth, and when we die immediately our soul will go to Heaven, Hell, or Purgatory.

This past month, I have been slowly wading my way through the book, "Purgatory and the Means to Avoid It." It was written in 1949 by Fr. Martin Jugie. It has an imprimatur and nihil obstat, and it's certainly not a fast or easy read. I have to keep looking up words in the dictionary, but it's well worth the effort. I read a little bit, but then I have to stop and ponder and consider how it pertains to my life and how well (or not well) I am doing.

Fr. Martin wrote that at the moment of our death, scales will fall from the eyes of our soul – and finally we will understand that God is ALL GOOD (words are too weak to convey how good God is). The soul experiences God as its ONLY SOURCE OF HAPPINESS! It is given a "mighty revelation" of the IMMENSITY of God's love (all earthly loves pale in comparison), and it will see how God has *always* enveloped it in His love, despite it being undeserving. While "an irresistible attraction draws" the soul to God, its energy is hindered due to its imperfections. The soul is devoured by the desire to make just reparation to God, yet "at the same time their hunger and thirst for the Beloved pierces them with the agony of longing." This insatiable longing for God is the great torment of Purgatory. . . "far exceeding all torments of this world" (p. 47).

I find this very comforting. The suffering of Purgatory isn't vengeful. It's not a shortened, weakened version of Hell, but it's a natural consequence that flows from having "seen" God and experiencing how *ABSOLUTELY WONDERFUL BEYOND WORDS* He is. However, the all-encompassing truth is that the soul is not ready or properly prepared to be with Him yet. The soul is devoured with the desire to make just amends for its transgressions and lack of love. Finally the soul starts loving God with the love that it should have loved Him with from the very beginning. This intense longing to be with God torments the soul but produces tremendous fruit.

Purgatory is real, but so are the means to avoid it. Over the next couple weeks I will share some of the ways Fr. Martin listed that will help us. This might seem like an odd topic for Lent, but I hope it will help us to be more intentional in pursuing holiness. It will help us choose our *prayer, penance, and almsgiving* in such a way that it will truly affect our eternity – and benefit those in Purgatory.
