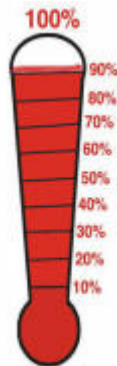

"How am I doing?" Part IV Praying Unceasingly

I hope this series on Purgatory has filled you with joy and hope. For me, I find that I am more aware of what I do and more deliberate in trying to be the best person I can be, even in accepting the crosses. I want to be as prepared as possible for the day I die. My motivation is because I love God, not out of fear. I want to be with Him.

We are blest to be part of the Communion of Saints, which includes three states intimately interconnected with each other; those in Heaven, in Purgatory, and us on earth. The love shared so freely between these states is vibrant and alive, even though we can't see it. The saints in Heaven pray for us unceasingly. They offer us the graces they earned while on earth, the things they struggled with and were able to triumph over. We on earth are called to pray unceasingly for those in Purgatory.

How can we help those who have died? The kindest and most charitable thing we can do is to pray unceasingly for them. Fr. Martin wrote that some of the saints feared that after they had died no one would pray for them because they assumed they were in Heaven already. Let's do our best to never forget them.

The ways we can do this are numerous and varied. Some include:

1) The most excellent way is to have a Mass said for the deceased. **Every** Mass contains within itself a prayer for **all** the faithful departed and asks that they be brought into Heaven. Every soul in Purgatory receives some benefit from every Mass. Our Church never forgets us. This is very consoling. Long after our family and friends have forgotten us, our Church remembers us and keeps on praying for us. Just think of how many Masses are offered every day throughout the world. We are so blessed to be part of the Catholic Church!

In addition, a Mass can be offered for a particular individual, which affords them even greater benefits. This tradition originated in the very early Church where inscriptions begging for prayers for the deceased have been found on the tombs in the catacombs.

2) An easy way to remember to pray for the dead is at mealtime. After you say grace you can add the prayer, "*May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.*"

3) I absolutely love our Necrology Book. In our parish, every day at Mass or Communion Service we pray for all those who have died on this day – and we ask for them to pray for us, too. If you haven't seen it before, it's in the narthex on the northwest wall. It includes the names of all the people who have died from Holy Rosary and those from our former mission parish in Alaska since the 1860's. This book is a tremendous gift to every person in our parish as we daily pray for all our deceased by name long after they have passed.

4) Everything that we do throughout the day can be turned into a prayer for the deceased. We can offer up any prayers, joys, works, and suffering for them. We can give alms in their name and do works of penance as we can remember them. This will benefit them, but it also helps us to turn our entire life into a prayer.

5) We can visit the cemetery and pray for those who are buried there. This Memorial Day we hope to have a Mass in our cemetery (if the snow is gone). This will be a wonderful way to gather together as a community to pray for all who have gone before us.

Heaven is going to be even better than any of us could have ever imagined. Let's do our part to pray for those in Purgatory.
