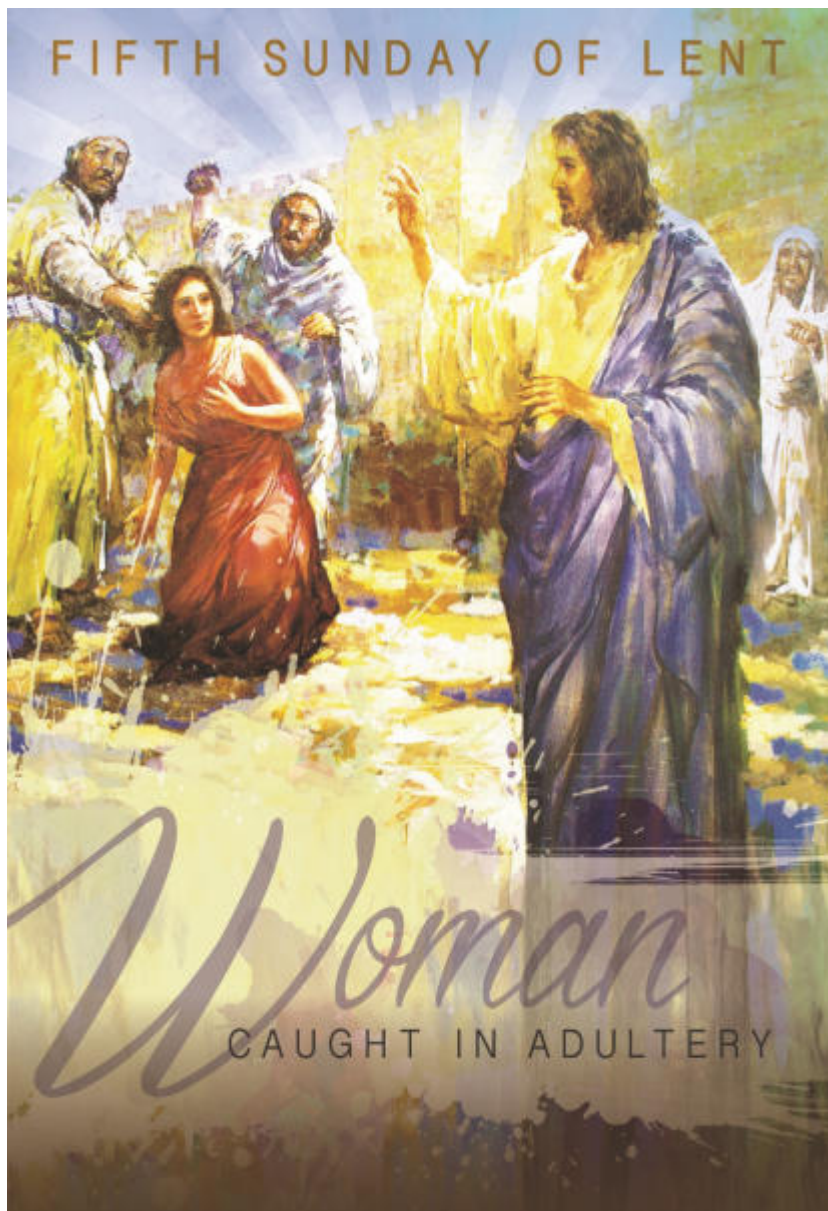

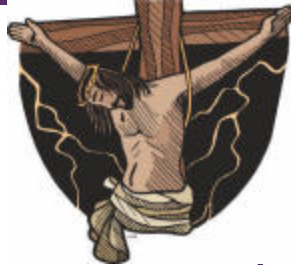

*I willingly stand in your place.*

In the Old Testament, the Old Law, God always defended the innocent. But as we heard in our Gospel today, Jesus defended the woman caught in adultery. As He did this, He was proclaiming a New Law: GOD WILL DEFEND THE GUILTY ALSO. This isn't anything new for us today, but it was a brand new concept for the Israelites. Up to this point, it was an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth. But now Jesus wrote a new law onto the earth – it was a law called MERCY and LOVE. Jesus stood with this woman. And He stands with us, too. All of us are guilty; ALL OF US NEED A SAVIOR.

If you were a 1st century Israelite, the lens through which you viewed every event in your life would be God parting the Red Sea and leading your ancestors into freedom from slavery in Egypt. But through the prophet Isaiah, God challenged them to something more: "Remember not the events of the past. . . See I am doing something new!" And that something new would be **God sending His Son, Jesus, who would open up the gates of Heaven** for all of us when He willingly died on the Cross, initiating His New Law of Love.

As baptized Catholics, Jesus dying on the Cross is the pivotal moment in our lives around which **EVERYTHING** revolves. Jesus parted the waters of OUR Red Sea to lead us to freedom. We can't tell the story of our lives without the foundation of all that Jesus has done for us.

The way sins were forgiven in the Old Testament was the person would go to the temple in Jerusalem to make a sin offering – the bigger the sin, the bigger the animal they brought to sacrifice. The animal represented their sins. They would put their hand on the animal as it was slaughtered, understanding that this animal had to die because of their sins. Then the priest would take it and offer it to God asking for forgiveness on their behalf.

***This is what we do in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.*** But I don't have to drag along an animal to atone for my sins because Jesus is my sin offering. He is already there in the Confessional waiting for me, willing to die for me.

And Jesus, in His goodness, turns everything around. Instead of me putting my hand on the sin offering, Jesus, who is the sacrifice, puts HIS hand on my head and says (through the priest), "**I absolve you from your sins. . .**" It's like Jesus is saying, "You are mine. I willingly stand in your place."

We should remember this every time we go to Confession, but also when we venerate the Cross on Good Friday. As we reach out to touch or kiss the Cross, I suggest that we recall this practice from our Jewish heritage of placing our hand on the animal to be sacrificed for our sins. Reach out and touch the Cross, understanding that Jesus IS your sacrificial Lamb. Thank Him for standing in your place.

It's not too late to come to the Sacrament of Reconciliation before Easter – but it is getting close. Call the parish office if you need to make an appointment. May you accept Jesus' offer to stand in your place.
