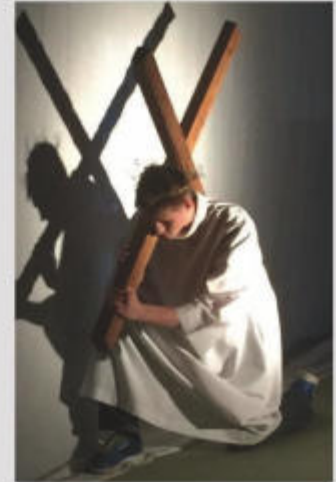

Love Held Jesus There

Why would Jesus die for us? IT IS A MYSTERY. Not a mystery to be solved, but a mystery meaning *beyond our ability to grasp.*

Jesus was a real person. He made real choices. He was fully man, and at the same time, fully God. We might think life was easy for Him because after all He was God so He could fall back on His divinity whenever He ran into difficulty – but He never did. He **CHOSE** to bear the heavy weight of sin and experience every temptation, pain, and emotion that all people, for all time, would ever experience – beginning with Adam and Eve's disobedience up until the last sin that will be committed at end of the world. All so He could triumph over them **for us** and pay the debt that we could not pay. *Why would He care so much?*

His passionate love **for us** drove Him. We don't understand love at this depth. His love held Him on the Cross; it wasn't the nails. St. Catherine of Siena wrote, "The nails could not have held Him fast to the Cross, if love had not held Him there first."

All of us have this spot deep inside of us that can only be filled by God. That's how we were created. We might not be able to identify this longing as such, but it's there. We don't know how to handle this restlessness. We try to fill it up with all kinds of things. We might try to numb it over so we don't feel it, yet in His mysterious way, God continues to draw all of us to Himself.

All people feel this longing. Many are looking for a church to attend this Easter. Deep down they want to go *somewhere*. Why not invite them (your neighbour, relative or fallen-away Catholic) to join you for Easter? (and for Holy Week as well) Don't be afraid to share how important your faith is to you.

Whenever Eileen and I invite people to return to the Church, often they hesitate, "*What would people say if I show up at Mass?*" We answer, "We hope, 'Nice to see you!'" Why not offer to pick them up so they don't have to sit alone? Or invite them to brunch afterwards or to our Easter Egg Hunt?

For the most part, we Catholics keep our faith private. Many of us feel nervous talking about the things most important to us. We feel unsure of ourselves and don't want to be rejected.

*But what if **you** were the instrument that God wanted to use to bring someone back to Church and restore their relationship with Jesus?*

You probably already have someone on your heart. Say a prayer first, and then invite them. I think you'll find it wasn't so bad. Even if they don't come, they'll appreciate that you cared. It's a very small risk in comparison to Jesus' sacrifice for us.

This year we are blessed to have all Holy Week Masses and services here at Holy Rosary, so clear your calendar and come!

Why would Jesus care so much? It's a mystery, but it was His love! Come enter more fully into the greatest Love Story ever!
