

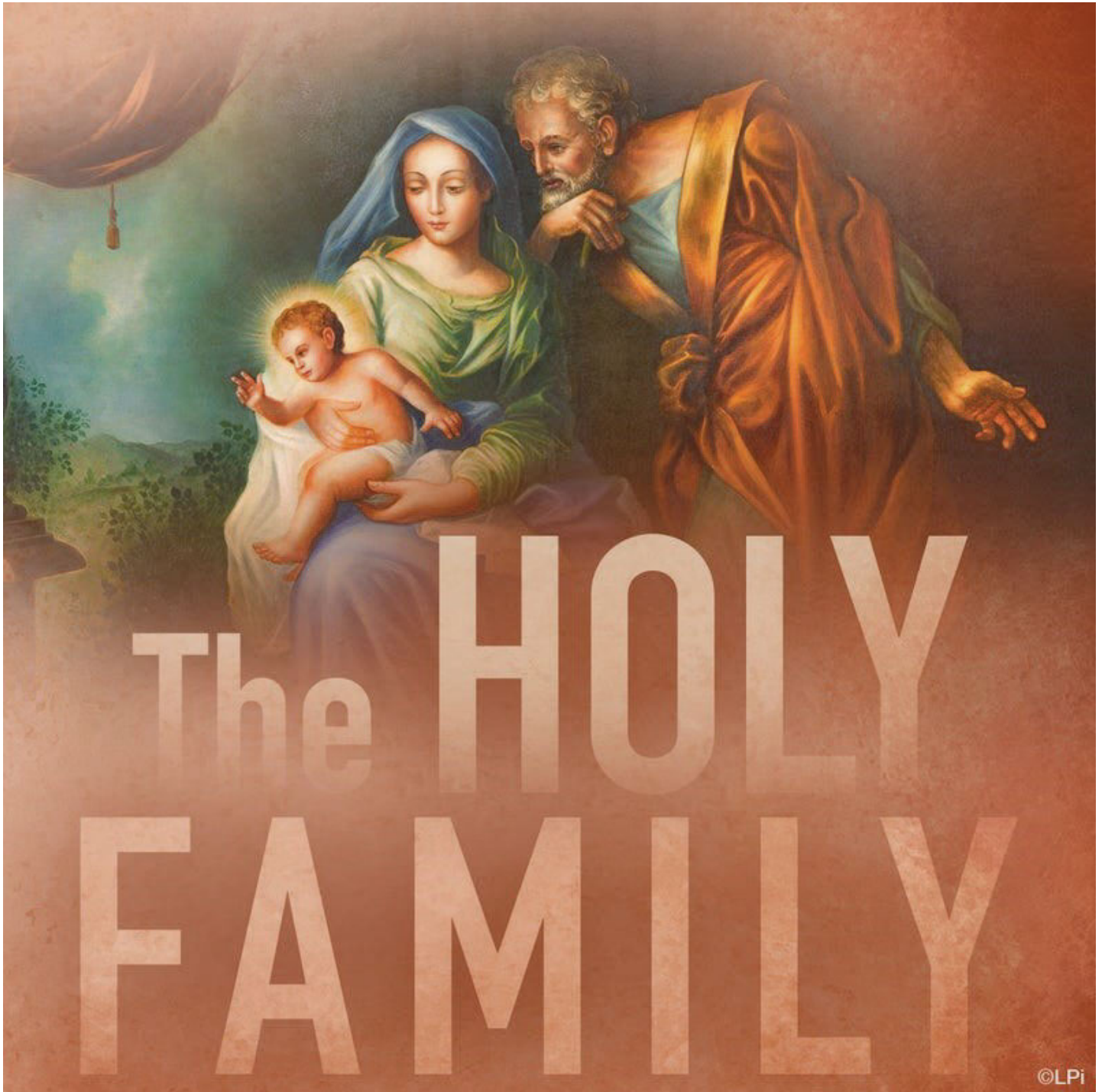

The celebration of Christmas is past; the New Year is right around the corner. Let's pause and look around us.

January 2021: We had hopes and fears for the year ahead. Perhaps you hoped with me that things would “normalize” a bit – but does that ever happen? We hoped for improvements while fearing what Covid might still do. Things continue to be bleak in that department! If Covid were not enough, awful things cling as we walk out of this year and toward the next: the awful events at the Waukesha Christmas parade, the school shootings in Oxford, MI and elsewhere, devastation suffered from tornadoes by our neighbors south of here, myriads of refugees and migrants digging and clawing to get free from atrocities and stifling poverty. Along with this comes the confusion out of this year's elections: an attack on our American democracy (which a year ago seemed pretty secure). I would love to leave all that behind on New Year's Eve but much of it will precede us into 2022. Ugh!

But please don't stop reading this letter here! Know we are being tempted (pay attention to that word tempted; you know who the Tempter is!) to give up, which brings up another serious problem. Many people have given up and have given in to suicide. Will we find hope in the New Year?

Yes! But we have to look outside ourselves for the answer. Over 2000 years ago, God sent a Savior to help us deal with the situations we face today. This same Jesus is as available to us as He was to Peter, James and John. This same Jesus wants to reach out to us as He reached out to the Samaritan woman, the demoniac from whom He exorcised legions of demons, the thief on an adjacent cross who asked to be accepted into Jesus' Kingdom. The message of Christmas: a Child born in a barn changed the world!

Bishop Ricken challenges all of us to become “missionary disciples.” What that means is that we have to open the barn doors and carry that Baby outside with us. Babies are signs that God has hope for our world. Baby Jesus is our hope! Show Him your concerns and fears. Listen when He says, “Do not be afraid.” Pay attention when the grown-up Jesus says, “Love God with your whole heart and soul – and your neighbor as yourself.” (He knows that can be hard!) Take his word as a personal call. Better! Take His instruction as an invitation to walk as one with Him wherever you go in the year ahead – and with everyone you meet. When you feel really tested (or have failed), pray. Pray first for forgiveness. Make no excuses for your unloving words or actions. Then pray that God blesses the person you failed.

Do you know what? 2022 can be (will be!) a wonderful year, even if we have to dance a little to keep from being enveloped by those who prefer to lurk in the dark!
