



Prayer: The Stuff of Life

For many, prayer conjures up images of folded hands, closed eyes, bowed heads, and stained glass windows. It calls to mind the echoes of Gregorian chant and church organs, the recitation of the Our Father and Hail Mary, or the choir singing "On Eagle's Wings" at a funeral Mass. It brings back memories of the smell of candle wax, the fragrance of Easter flowers, and the pungent scent of incense. However, prayer is so much more. Prayer is the stuff of ordinary life, the whole of God's creation.

Through Baptism, each of us is called to become holy, for we are the daughters and sons of God. Becoming holy is a process. Matthew Kelly, Dynamic Catholic author and presenter, talks about creating "holy moments" one at a time until pretty soon you have more and more of them. Holy moments are those times when we are fully aware of the Lord's presence.

Just as with our human parents and children, the Lord's presence should never be far from our hearts and minds. Just as we try to celebrate holidays and other times with our families around the dinner table, we attend Mass to celebrate with the Lord's physical presence at the Eucharistic table.

There are so many other times, though, when we could be in the presence of the Lord. For example, we need to ask the Lord to join us as we go about our daily work: preparing meals, washing dishes, mowing the lawn, planting gardens, plowing fields, feeding livestock, or even picking stones. We need to take the Lord with us when we play...fishing, hunting, quilting, sledding, biking, crafting. We need to invite the Lord to look up at the night sky to gaze at the stars with us or out at the enigmatic waters of Lake Michigan. We need to invite him to walk through the forest with us as we breathe in the fragrance of pine and listen to the gurgling creek.

Having the Lord with us as we engage in all these activities transforms them into holy moments in which we recognize and give praise and thanks to our Creator God who gifted us with everything we see, hear, smell, taste, and feel. PRAY ALL WAYS, a book by Edward Hays, was this inspiration for this article. While I've always felt God's presence in nature and, somewhat later, in mundane tasks like washing dishes, Hays opened so many other vistas of prayer to me which I haven't even touched on here. I highly recommend this book.
