



"Pride is the beginning of all sin." st. Thomas Aquinas Some remedies against pride:

Humility teaches me the truth about myself & leads to penitence

- [†] Everything I am and every talent I have is a gift from God.
- ⁺ I have been created by God because He loves me.
- ⁺ I need God. I am totally dependent upon Him.

To cultivate humility within me, I can

- + ponder Jesus' words, "Without Me, you can do nothing." Jn 15:5
- + remind myself throughout the day that all my abilities and talents are gifts to me from God and to surrender myself to His will.
- + examine the motive behind my good works and do things for the greater honor and glory of God, not myself.
- + confess all my sins in Confession and accept Jesus' mercy.
- + pray for and do good to those who hurt or offend me.
- + in charity, train myself to appreciate the good qualities in others.

Obedience to God's Word will help me embrace His will. † I can make time to read the Bible and pray each day to be better able to hear and recognize His voice and carry out His will.

- + I can study the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* and strive to embrace the teachings of the Catholic Church.
- ⁺ With a priest, I can discuss the areas I have difficulty following the teachings of the Catholic Church and consider his explanation.

<u>Gratitude</u> turns my heart to God in thanksgiving for everything. † I can train myself to see the good & thank God for His blessings. † I can thank God for His commandments and guidance.

<u>Spiritual Poverty</u> relies on God's grace, guidance, and mercy. † I can pray a Morning Offering, offering to God all that I will do this day and leaving the results ("good" or "bad") to Him.

- + I can detach my heart voluntarily from the praise of others and attach my heart to God and seek His praise alone.
- $^{\rm +}$ I can let go of control and choose to trust God and His plan.
