

Today we study a few ways to oppose avarice.

"For the love of money is the root of all evils; it is through this craving that some have wandered away from the faith and pierced their hearts with many pangs." (1Tim 6:10)

Remedies to fight against avarice include:

Detachment keeps the love and desire for things in check + helps us turn to the Lord to supply all our physical & spiritual needs + teaches generosity so we can surrender things of the world, use only what is necessary, and guard our heart against attachment to things + helps one practice self-denial

Liberality / Generosity / Charity

+shares what one has freely and without attachment or resentment + generously uses money and possessions for worthy charities according to one's means

+ stays focused on God; and when giving, gives as if unto God Himself + uses God's resources with respect

+ joyfully shares time, talent, & treasure with others without expecting anything in return

+ enables us "to love God above all things for His own sake, and our neighbor as ourselves for the love of God" (Catechism, 1822) + if one wants to strongly combat avarice and strengthen the practice of this virtue, give away those things to which you are most attached.

Faith is a theological virtue which enables one "to live by right conduct that fulfills the twofold commandment of charity" of loving God and loving neighbor as himself (Catechism p. 879)

+ enables one to freely commit "his entire self to God" (CCC 1814) + helps one trust & believe that God will take care of them in all ways

Prudence shows how to act & use good judgment in what God has given us
