Today we study a few ways to oppose avarice.

***"For the love of money is the root of all evils;
it is through this craving
that some have wandered away from the faith
and pierced their hearts with many pangs." (1Tim 6:10)***

Remedies to fight against avarice include:

- Detachment** keeps the love and desire for things in check
 - + helps us turn to the Lord to supply all our physical & spiritual needs
 - + teaches generosity so we can surrender things of the world, use only what is necessary, and guard our heart against attachment to things
 - + helps one practice self-denial
- Liberality / Generosity / Charity**
 - + shares what one has freely and without attachment or resentment
 - + generously uses money and possessions for worthy charities according to one's means
 - + stays focused on God; and when giving, gives as if unto God Himself
 - + uses God's resources with respect
 - + joyfully shares time, talent, & treasure with others without expecting anything in return
 - + enables us "to love God above all things for His own sake, and our neighbor as ourselves for the love of God" (*Catechism*, 1822)
 - + if one wants to strongly combat avarice and strengthen the practice of this virtue, *give away those things to which you are most attached.*
- Faith** is a theological virtue which enables one "to live by right conduct that fulfills the twofold commandment of charity" of loving God and loving neighbor as himself (*Catechism* p. 879)
 - + enables one to freely commit "his entire self to God" (CCC 1814)
 - + helps one trust & believe that God will take care of them in all ways
- Prudence** shows how to act & use good judgment in what God has given us
