Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a several-month process for an adult wishing to become a Catholic through the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) or through a Profession of Faith. These rites are celebrated at the Easter Vigil. Please call the Parish Office.

Infant Baptism is generally celebrated on the first and third Sundays of the month at 2:00 pm in the Church. The Baptism Preparation Program for parents and godparents, if possible, is held each month. Please call the Parish Office to make arrangements.

Confirmation Adolescent Confirmation Sacramental Preparation is a structured 2 (two)-year faith journey beginning in junior high in our School and our religious education program, Family Program, and continuing through high school to complete the 2-year requirement. Adult Confirmation Sacramental Preparation takes place in a subcategory of the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. For more information please contact Barb Cegielski, Director of Religious Education.

The Eucharist is brought to the homebound by Care Ministers. Arrangements are made by calling Mary Ann Harvey at 847-323-6910. First Eucharist preparation for children begins in first grade and is celebrated in the spring of second grade. For more information contact Barb Cegielski.

Matrimony arrangements made a year in advance allow for adequate reservation time, participation in marriage preparation programs and liturgical planning. Please call the Parish Office.

Anointing of the Sick is celebrated in the Fall during a communal celebration. Special requests for this sacrament can be arranged by calling the Parish Office.

Reconciliation is celebrated on select Saturdays from 3:30pm to 4:30pm through Sign-Up Genius. Communal Reconciliation Services are held during Advent and Lent.

Dear St. Athanasius Community:

The Road to Conversion

When I am driving, I really find it useful that the GPS reroutes my navigation when anticipating traffic or any accident ahead on the road. I hear a little beeping or a voice asking me whether I would like to accept the option given or not. It does really make a difference in my driving experience knowing the advantages of changing routes.

The readings this weekend invites us to think that while traveling in this life, it is never too late to change our personal routes, our minds, and hearts to follow God's directions. For instance, the people of Nineveh were invited by the prophet Jonah to change the route their lives were taking. For many years the people of this city had fallen away from God. Their hearts were attached to cruelty, oppression and sinful ways of living. The prophet Jonah became God's voice for them. God sends Jonah to Nineveh, "the great city," telling him that its evil "has come up" before him (Jonah 1:2). Jonah warned people of the dangers ahead if they didn't turn their lives back to God. It was through Jonah's prophetic voice and call to conversion that the people of Nineveh repented.

St. Paul is another example, too. On his way to Damascus he had a remarkable experience of conversion. Not only did he change his physical route, but he also changed his whole life journey—from persecuting Christians to becoming a zealous defender of our Christian faith. Thanks to him and his conversion, the gospel has been preached out to us. If we would like to know when it would be a good time to repent, St. Paul would say that the time is now. In today's reading St. Paul tells us that "time is running out." (1 Corinthians 7:29). He brings a sense of urgency for conversion. He urges his listeners to change their way of living their lives, repent and give their lives to God.

God spoke to Nineveh through the prophet Jonah, and to St. Paul by confronting them with their own selfish actions. We are also in our journey towards God. And along the way, we might need to be open to change directions. This is when God speaks to us through our conscience. He invites us to know that it is never too late to reorient our lives, and change our personal perspectives. He knows what is best for us. Let us listen to that inner voice that is rerouting for us what we cannot see for ourselves.





THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Lectionary: 68

READING I Jonah 3:1-5, 10

The word of the LORD came to Jonah, saying: “Set out for the great city of Nineveh, and announce to it the message that I will tell you.” So Jonah made ready and went to Nineveh, according to the LORD’S bidding. Now Nineveh was an enormously large city; it took three days to go through it. Jonah began his journey through the city, and had gone but a single day’s walk announcing, “Forty days more and Nineveh shall be destroyed,” when the people of Nineveh believed God; they proclaimed a fast and all of them, great and small, put on sackcloth.

When God saw by their actions how they turned from their evil way, he repented of the evil that he had threatened to do to them; he did not carry it out.
