School Budget

Total revenue parish is 5% over budget. Revenue this quarter included Lenten Almsgiving and the special collection for Ukraine. These revenues are pass through; while recorded as income when they are dispersed an expense will be recorded to offset the revenue. Envelope contributions are down 5%. Salaries are under budget by almost 40%. Finance Council has decided not to fill 2 positions budgeted for this year to help reduce the projected deficit at the beginning of the fiscal year. Other expenses are falling within expectations for this point in the fiscal year. Net profit this quarter is down from mid-year due to a combination of decreased revenue and significant increase in utility costs

Tuition revenue for the school is right on budget. Salaries are under budget by 37% due to receipt of the last Employee Retention Credit payment from the federal government. Without that credit, salaries and benefits would still be under budget due to lower than expected health care premium costs and pension reserve. All other expenses are well within expectations.

Finance Council continues to watch the fiscal performance of the parish and school as good stewards of the contributions received from you. Year end results will not be available until audits are completed in the fall.

Thank you for your continued financial support of St. Matthias Parish and School.

Election of a Trustee

It is that time of year again when we must choose a new trustee. Our trustees serve two year terms which are staggered so that every year we are electing one. Any parishioner can nominate him/herself or another parishioner by gathering 10 signatures of parishioners for that person, provided the candidate is:

-Catholic -A registered, practicing parish member -25 years old

We can have as many candidates as are nominated and the parish director is allowed to nominate one. If we have at least two candidates we will have a parish wide election, otherwise the candidate that I appoint is the chosen candidate. I am nominating Paul Ziehler for the open parish trustee position.

Trustees are the major check signers for the parish and safeguard parish funds. The are ex officio members of the Pastoral Council and members of the Finance Council. If you have any questions about being a trustee, please feel free to call the parish office (414.321.0893) and ask for me.


