# Divine Mercy Sunday April 24, 2022 2:30PM Today we celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy. There will be a special time of prayer beginning at 2:30PM. Included will be the Litany of Trust, readings from the diary of St. Faustina, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, chanting of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and concluding with Benediction.

Confessions will not be available during this time so you are encouraged to go sometime before the feast.



## Prayer to St. Michael

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil; May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; And do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, cast into hell Satan and all evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

# Praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet

Using regular rosary beads, begin with the Sign of the cross (1).

Next, say the **optional Opening Prayer (2):** "You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us. (*Repeat 3 times*) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!"

## Then pray the Our Father (3), Hail Mary (4) and the Apostles Creed (5).

**On the standalone beads (7), pray:** "Eternal Father, I offer you the body, blood, soul, and divinity of your dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world."




On the decade beads (8), pray: "For the sake of his sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us

and on the whole world."

At the end (9), pray the following three times: "Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world."

It is typical to conclude the Divine Mercy Chaplet with the three words: **"Jesus, I trust in You."**




