



Diocesan Blessing of the Harvest


All are invited to join Father Godfrey for

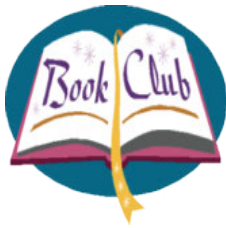
**Traveling Chalice Program

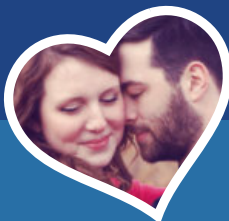
