Weekly Message from Father Manno



Newman Family,


We have now officially entered into Ordinary Time. The truth, though, is that there is nothing *ordinary* at all about this season. In fact, the "ordinary" in Ordinary Time simply comes from the Latin root "ordo" which means *order*. And so the

season is named because we are simply ordering the weeks with successive numbers. Ordinary Time week one, Ordinary Time week two, and so on until we enter into the solemn season of Lent. What better time to order our life, our prayer habits, and yes, even our entire beings then during a season which actually takes its name from that very idea?

Ask yourself today what things in your life need to be better ordered. A simple way to gain greater insight into which parts of your life need a little attention in this area is to look for the chaos. For where there is chaos, there is almost always a lack of order. If your morning is chaotic, make a plan for how to better bring order to it. If your prayer life is chaotic, plan how to better organize it, hour by hour and day by day. And if your Mass attendance has proved chaotic, make a better plan for how to approach that, as well.

Bring all your chaos to Jesus and allow Him to reveal to you the perfect way to bring order to whatever area of your life most needs it. And then pray that this Ordinary Time bears the fruit of a life that contains more and more of the essence of Christ's life with each passing day.




