Godparents must be active members of a parish and recommended by their pastor. Adults and/or older children seeking baptism do so according to the Rites of Christian Initiation of Adults. Thursdays before First Friday 3:00 to 4:00 PM.  
Saturdays 3:00 to 4:00 PM. Communal celebration of Reconciliation seasonally scheduled, and also by appointment.

### CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place in Religious Education classes and our parish grade school. All other parishioners wishing confirmation please call the Parish Office to arrange preparation.

### MARRIAGE AND MARRIAGE VALIDATIONS

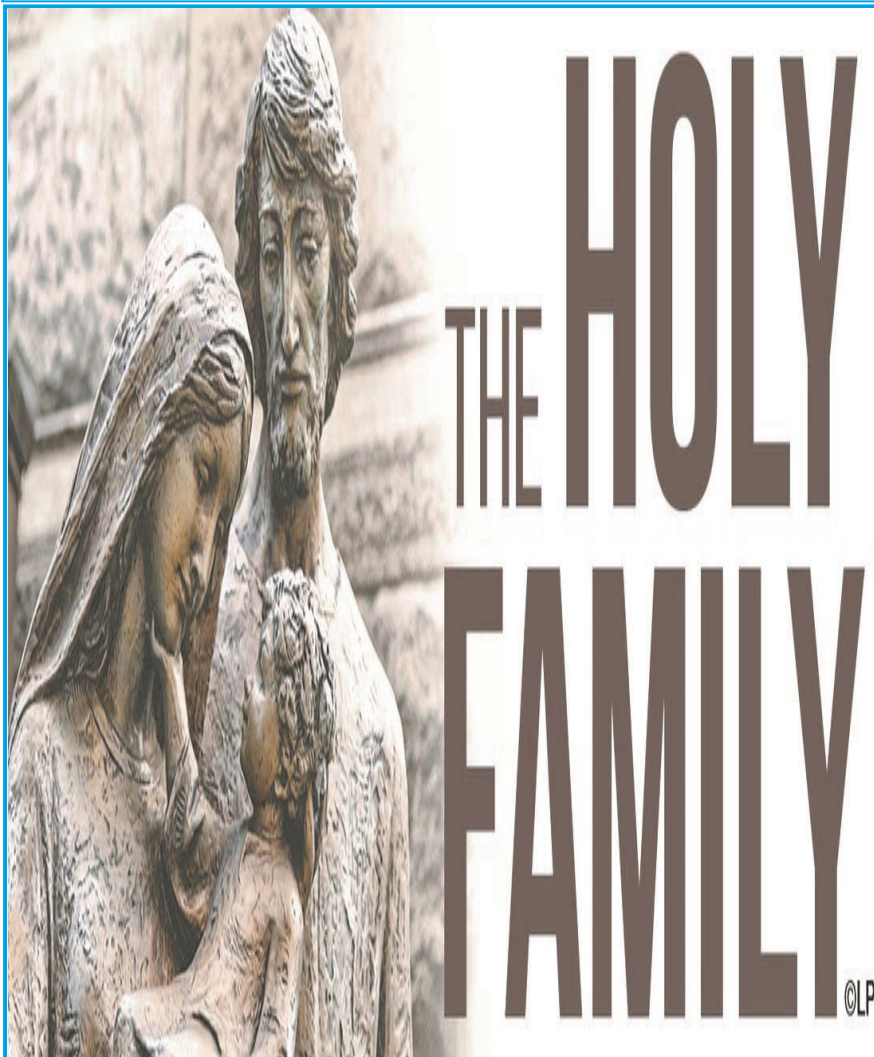
### ANOINTING OF THE SICK AND VISITATION

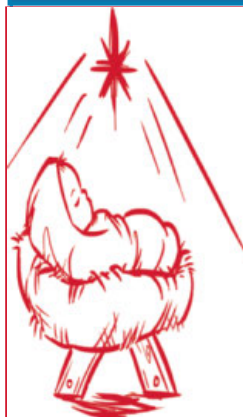

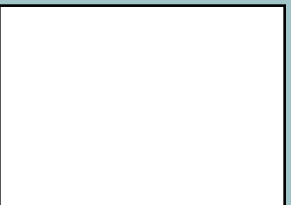

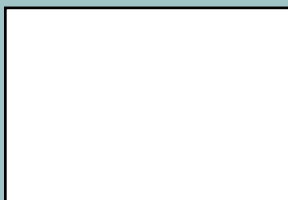
