LETTER from Fr. Browning

The New Year brings an opportunity for spiritual renewal. It is time to evaluate our life of faith. Jesus said, "seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things shall be yours as well (Mt 6:33)." If we made this our daily goal, we would quickly progress in our spiritual life. I propose three areas on which to focus.

- 1) The Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. This year renew your dedication to Sunday Mass and Holy Days. God commands us to go to Mass not because He needs us to worship Him but because He knows we need it. The best way to pray and grow in holiness outside of Mass is Adoration. Please consider dedicating an hour a week to adoring Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.
- 2) **Confession** is a sacrament of healing. It is the sacrament that reconciles us with the Father, the Church, and one another. When we sin mortally, we have separated ourselves from the grace that saves us. We need to repent and begin again. The biblical image is of the paralyzed man on the stretcher brought to Jesus. He is first forgiven of his

- sins and then healed. Spiritually this is what happens in confession. Make it a regular family practice this year. It's incredible, do not be afraid!
- 3) 3) Prayer is a conversation with God. It is the raising of our mind and heart to God. All of the Saints speak of the necessity of prayer for our salvation. Pick up my "Prayer Prescription" booklet on how to pray. Be faithful to a specific time of prayer each day. Persevere when it isn't easy. When you fail (you will, I do), begin again!

These three practices will help us put into place Jesus' command to seek first the kingdom of God and its righteousness. We will grow together as a parish family. We will become disciples who share Jesus with others. We will find God's peace and goodness amidst the sufferings of this life. We will grow in holiness.

Weekend Volunteers
