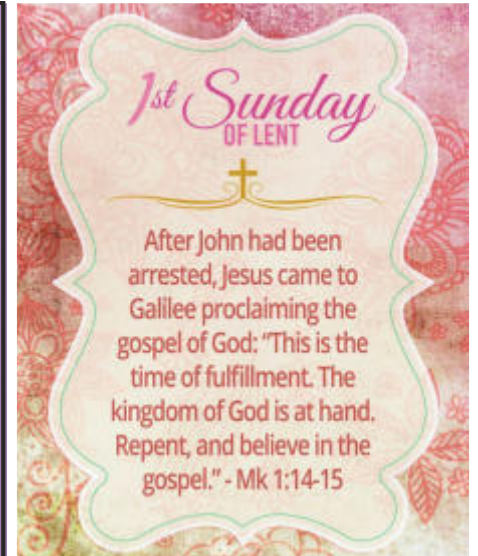

Each week, I select the names of two students who met their goals in their tech programs and buy them the lunch of their choice. It is a small gesture to encourage continued progress toward goals, even amidst the challenges that our students continue to face throughout this unprecedented year. We are currently registering our students for either in-person or digital learning for trimester III. I know that many of our students who have been remote all year are anxious to return to in-person learning, so we may have to get a little creative with scheduling. However, we are planning for a return to a 'normal' year for the fall and would love to enroll any friends, family members or neighbors that you know who might be looking for a great faith-based learning environment.

Lastly, I want to update you on where we are at with our tuition assistance dollars. At the beginning of the year, we needed \$18,560 to support the students who needed assistance. 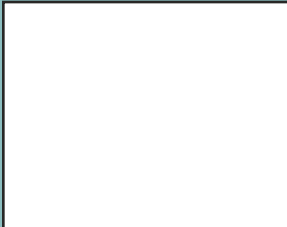
