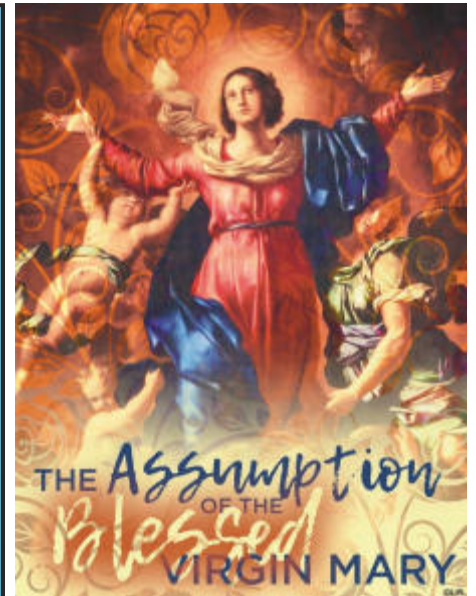

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

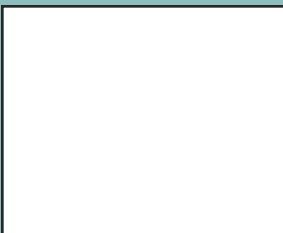
