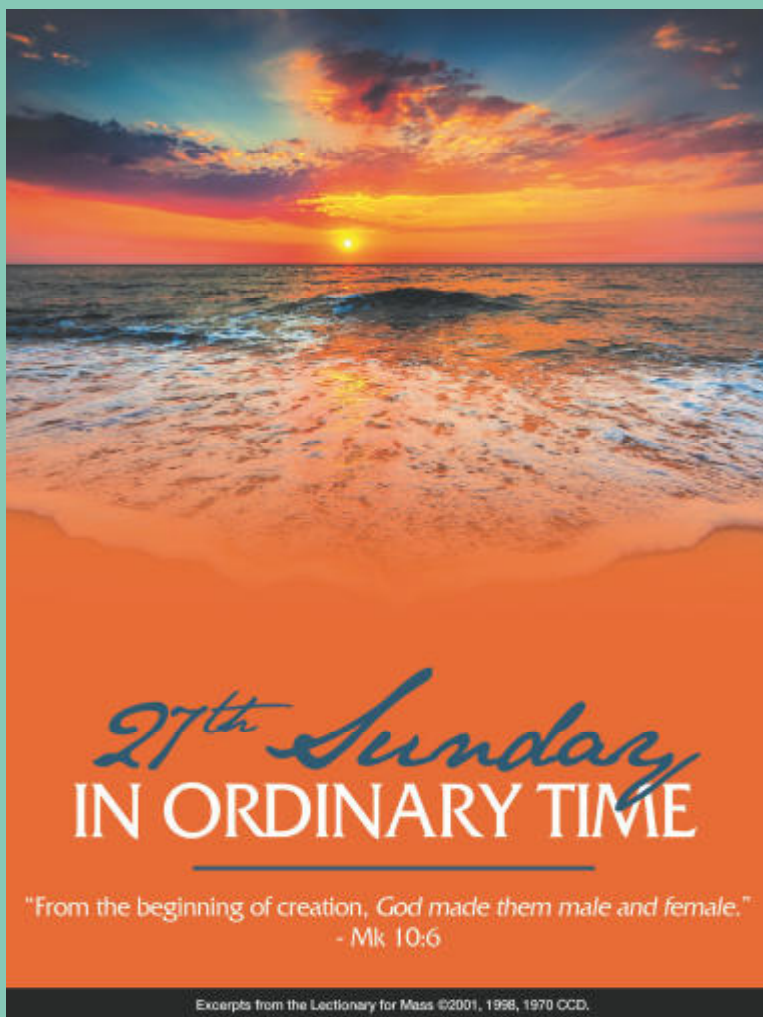

Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel

St. Michael the Archangel,
Defend us in battle.

Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the devil.
May God rebuke him, we humbly pray and do thou,
O Prince of the heavenly hosts,
By the power of God,
Cast into hell satan,
And all the evil spirits,
Who prowl about the world
Seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

This prayer written by Pope Leo XIII employing St. Michael the Archangel to defend God's people and God's Church from evil and the powers of darkness. It was prayed at the end of low Mass from 1886 until it was stopped in 1964 as the Second Vatican Council (1962 – 1965) was ending.

Pope Francis, in a recent statement, requested the faithful to invoke the aid and powerful intercession of the Blessed Mother and St. Michael for the Church by praying a daily Rosary during the month of October which is traditionally regarded as a Marian Month. The above Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel is to be added to the daily Rosary.

In making the appeal to the faithful in the context of the devastating revelations of sex abuse in our Church and the failure of episcopal leadership in some places, in addressing the problem, Pope Francis is "asking the faithful of the whole world to pray so that the Mother of God puts the Church under her protective mantle to preserve her from the attacks of the evil one, the great accuser, and to make [the Church] all the more conscious of the faults, the mistakes, the abuses made in the present and in the past, and more committed to fighting without any hesitation for evil not to prevail." As Francis wisely said, "Only prayer can defeat the devil." Prayer is always helpful. It strengthens our resolve and endows us with the wisdom and clarity of vision needed to proceed to salutary action.

Interestingly, Pope Francis is not the only Pope to ask the faithful to invoke St. Michael's intercession using the above-mentioned prayer. St. John Paul in 1994 asked the faithful to do the same saying: "although this prayer is no longer recited at the end of Mass, I ask everyone not to forget it and to recite it to obtain help in the battle against the forces of darkness and against the spirit of this world."

The Marian Prayer recommended by Pope Francis to be prayed at the end of the Rosary is an ancient prayer said to be written in the 3rd century. It goes like this:

We fly to thy patronage, O holy Mother of God;
despise not our petitions in our necessities,
but deliver us from all dangers,
O ever glorious and blessed Virgin. Amen.

These two prayers may be cut and pasted on the refrigerator door and prayed daily during this month of October!

May the Blessed Virgin, one of whose title is Mother of the Church, watch over the Church and protect her. May St. Michael the Archangel defend us all from the attacks of Satan and all the evil spirits, who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Fr. Amadi
