

# RESPECT LIFE MASS

Last Saturday, our parish was blessed to host the Archdiocesan Respect Life Mass. Archbishop Listecki presided and preached this Mass. He was very pleased to see such a packed church. He said this is the first time he recalls such a good turnout. As I looked around, I noticed many of the attendees were parishioners of St. John's. The visitors who came commented on the Archbishop's powerful Respect Life homily. Also, I heard many positive comments regarding the beautiful and inspiring music by our parish staff and cantors.

The Archbishop delivered a very strong Pro-Life homily and received many positive comments. 
