Ordinary Time Music Update

For Ordinary Time during the summer months, we will be introducing a new sung Gloria.

This Gloria is from the Roman Missal Chants. We often refer to it as the Chant Mass. We have been utilizing the Eucharistic Acclamations not only during Advent and Lent, but throughout the pandemic, except for Christmas and Easter, where we sing Mass of Creation.

The Gloria is a through-composed Gloria - meaning it does not have a refrain. We sing it as we would recite it. Also, the Chant Mass Gloria is repetitive, which is helpful as we learn it now. Once we have hymnals again, it is in our hymnal within the Order of Mass section.

We will begin utilizing this Gloria the weekend of June 12-13, 2021 – the Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time.







The Parental Notice of Abortion Act is a proven, commonsense law that protects our minor daughters from medical injury and sexual exploitation, and keeps parents informed about their minor daughter's wellbeing. Two identical bills have been introduced in the Illinois General Assembly to repeal this law - one in the Illinois House (HB 1797) and one in the Illinois Senate (SB 2190). There is a strong possibility supporters of this bill will wait until the last days of this session, Memorial Day Weekend, to call it to committee and for a vote. 

He was born in Nablus, Palestine about the year 100 to a family of pagan Greek origin. As a young man he looked for truth from many

philosophies and teachers of his time, especially Plato. However, he found Platoism wanting and lacking in the answers to his questions. Walking along the seashore one day, he met an old man who asked him what he was looking for. Justin answered, "The meaning of life." The stranger told him to turn to the Christian faith that Jesus Christ revealed. After prayer and study, he became a Christian when he was about thirty years old. From his own experience, he knew there were many people like himself searching for truth, so he began writing and teaching about Christianity in Rome and other great cities. He introduced himself to Emperor Antonius, the Roman Senate, and the influential teachers and figures of his time. Not only did he propose the beauty and wisdom of his faith, but he also answered those who misrepresented or ridiculed the Christian religion. He is considered to be the first Christian 'apologist,' or defender of the faith, of the second century. His two great writings are Apologies and Dialogue with Trypho. He opened a school in Rome where his teachings increasingly disturbed the authorities. At the instigation of the Cynic philosopher, Crescens, whom he defeated in a debate, Justin was denounced as a Christian and arrested with six companions. Justin and the six other Christians who where on trial were sentenced to be scourged and then beheaded for their faith in Jesus Christ. He died in 165. He is the patron of philosophers, apologists, and lecturers.
