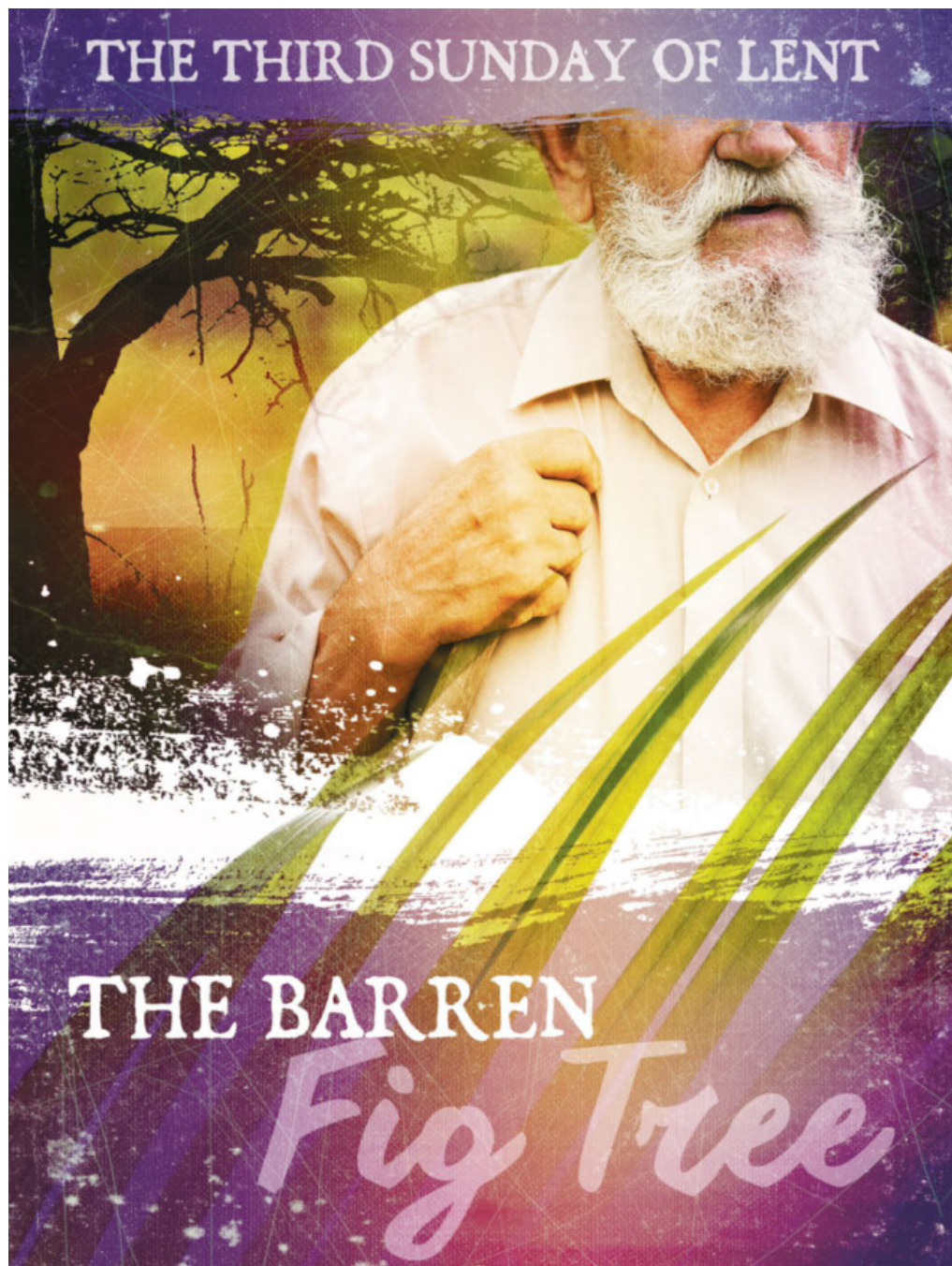

CEMETERY PLANTING REGULATIONS

For both St. Mary's & St. Joseph's

Planting should only be done on the front side of the headstone. Plants must be in a cultivated area, not more than 18 inches in front of and not greater than the length of the headstone.

- **NO** continuous flower beds from headstone to neighboring headstones.
- **NO** decorative stone in flower beds. Decorations in poor taste or in excess will be removed by Cemetery Personnel
- In remembrance of our Veterans, flags will only be permitted on those grave sites.
- Decorations can be put on starting Mother's Day weekend.

The regulations are to help enhance the appearance and facilitate the lawn cutting.

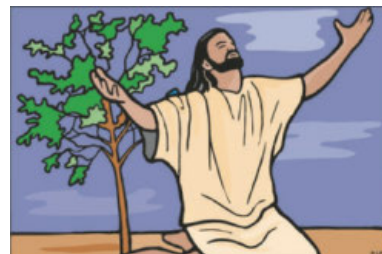
