

CEMETERY PLANTING REGULATIONS For both St. Mary's & St. Joseph's

- Planting should only be done on the front side of the headstone. Plants must be in a cultivated area, not more than <u>18 inches</u> in front of and not greater than the length of the headstone.
- <u>NO</u> continuous flower beds from headstone to neighboring headstones.
- <u>NO</u> decorative stone in flower beds. Decorations in poor taste or in excess will be removed by Cemetery Personnel
- In remembrance of our Veterans, flags will only be permitted on those grave sites.
- Fall & winter decorations are to be removed by April 15, after that date they will be removed.
- Summer decorations can be put on starting Mother's Day weekend.

The regulations are to help enhance the appearance and facilitate the lawn cutting.


