

### TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

#### Who Do You Say That I Am?

Jesus asked this question of the disciples when they were in Caesarea Philippi, a Greco-Roman city known for its temples to their gods. Jesus brought his disciples to this place, where a temple for the god Pan had been built. The place was believed to be the entrance to the underworld. Niches were carved on the main cliff for idols and gods. Also people had built altars and made sacrifices as a sign of worship. Caesarea Philippi was the place where Jesus decided to ask his disciples the question, "Who do you say that I am?" It was a confrontation to the beliefs of the world. There is only one God and Jesus himself is the Son. Peter's confession is the voice of the Church: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Our confession of faith echoes Peter's confession. When we are presented with idols, obsessions, passions, or desires from the world, we are to profess Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the living God. In order for us to set aside the idols and gods of the world, we need to know who Jesus is. Jesus is asking you: Who you say that I am?

People have many different views about God and Jesus. Our understanding of God and Jesus is the basis of our faith and the practice of our beliefs. What is your idea of God? Who is Jesus for you? People might have different understandings about God based on their own experiences. For some, God might be a loving father; for others, the creator of the universe; for some others, the judge at the end of the age. But who is God? Saint John says that God is love. Love is not one more of the attributes of God; love is the very essence of his being.

Many people deny the existence of God because they can't wrap their minds around it. How can a being create everything else? Who created that being? Certainly, we cannot fully comprehend the mystery of God, but we can reasonably come to a conclusion on his existence. Some atheists, such as Feuerbach, say that God is a projection of our idealized self-understanding: "The no to God is the yes to humanity." Marx says that religion is the opium of the people while Sartre says: "If God exists, I can't be free, but I am free, therefore God does not exist." All these views come from the idea of God as one more being in the universe, but God is outside creation. The true God is not one being among many because God is being itself.

What is your understanding of Jesus? Who is Jesus for you? For some people Jesus might be a prophet, for others he might be a great teacher, for still others he might be a healer. Jesus is the Messiah, which means the one who was sent to fulfill the prophecies of old. God became one of us; God became human. God took to himself a human nature to free the same nature he took upon himself. Throughout the history of the Church, the person of Jesus has been misunderstood. For some, Jesus has been only a human person; Nestorianism says that Jesus is a human person with a highly intense relationship with God; he is human but is not truly divine. Others say that Jesus was only divine; Monophysitism states that Jesus is God; he is truly divine but not truly human. Still others say that Jesus is partially human and partially divine; Arianism argues that Jesus is kind of human and kind of divine. Since the Council of Chalcedon, the Church says that Jesus is truly human and truly divine. What is your understanding of Jesus? We need to echo the same words that Peter said in Caesarea Philippi: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

The parish picnic has been a feature at Saint Catherine's for many years now. Parishioners always love to share food, fun, and fellowship. It is a great opportunity to build community and strengthen the bonds of friendship among all. Last year we needed to cancel the picnic due to the pandemic. We thank all those who make the picnic possible; so many people contributed their time, talent, and treasure to this event. I pray this time together will help us grow closer to each other and closer to God.

The trust that is fostered from resting with the Divine One allows us to see that God's ways are not our ways. There is something bigger going on in this picture of life. It is something mystical and magical that seeks to surprise us at every turn. It is not for us to cling to this world and its limitations. Our adventure is to dream bigger and brighter, realizing that it is even in suffering that the radiant light of the dawn will come. God's ways allow for our paths to be rocky, challenging, difficult, and even crippling at times. Purely human eyes cannot understand the 'why' of such experiences. The eyes and mind of God, however, reveal and detail a journey that ends in glorious resurrection joy. When we lose our axis and become too human in our thinking, Jesus rebukes us and gently reminds us how to see.

## FATIMA, PORTUGAL LUCIA'S WORDS

The 13th of September 1917

When they finally arrived at the holm oak, Lucia as usual started the Rosary, with the people responding. They were almost finished when the children arose to scan the horizon. They had seen the flash. Our Lady would soon come. A few moments passed. A globe of light appeared before the crowd, and the all Holy Queen of Angels was standing over the holm oak.

"What do You want of me?" Lucia spoke very humbly. "Let the people continue to say the Rosary every day to obtain the end of the war," Our Lady responded.... "In the last month, in October, I shall perform a miracle so that all may believe in My apparitions. ... Saint Joseph will come with the Baby Jesus to give peace to the world. Our Lord also will come to bless the people. Our Lady of the Rosary and Our Lady of Sorrows will also come. God is pleased with your sacrifices but does not wish that you wear the rope when you go to sleep. Wear it only during the day." Lucia then said, "Many people say that I am a swindler who should be hanged or burned. Please perform a miracle for all to believe." "Yes, in October, I will perform a miracle so that all may believe." "Some people gave me these letters for you and a bottle of cologne." Lucia did not want to forget any requests. "None of that is needed in Heaven."

Our Lady then began to leave. Lucia, pointing towards the East, shouted to the people, "If you want to see Our Lady, look that way!" They looked eagerly towards the East and many saw the luminous globe now ascending towards Heaven.


### Curriculum Night





