From Father Nicholas' desk... Truth and Mercy Series (XXXVI)

This weekend is special indeed!! We are celebrating the TWO HEARTS of Jesus and Mary between Friday and Saturday and the Birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Sunday: September 6, 7 and 8 respectively. These celebrations are so important to God the Father. Jesus and Mary are the second Adam and second Eve spoken about in 1 Corinthians 15, "the first man, Adam, as scripture says, became a living soul, but the last man (second) has become a life-giving spirit. That is, first the one with the soul, not the spirit, and after that, the one with the spirit. The first man, being from the earth, is earthly by nature; the second man is from heaven.... As the heavenly man is, so are we in heaven. And we who have been modelled on the earthly man, will be modelled on the heavenly man." (v. 45-49).

God has brought us a new set of models after the fall of the first parents and ancestors. In order to fashion the new creation, God made Jesus who became flesh in the womb of the Virgin Mary. Mary conceived Him and loved Him in Her Heart first before Her womb. As the scripture above says, the second man is from heaven. The psalm is so clear that "Our Help comes from the Lord whom made heaven and earth." (Psalm 12:12). The Word of God is also clear as to how the world was created in the first place. His form of help is to form a new people for God. As the head of the body, the Church, His task is to be the "way, the truth and the life." (John 14:6). Jesus is the exemplar of the path of holiness for all of God's children. This is the reason he says, "Learn of me for I am gentle and humble of heart." (Matthew 11: 29). Unlike Adam Jesus calls us to recognize the will of God our Father in the choices we make. Unlike Adam, it is not "I can do whatever I like" or "No one can tell me what to do." It is in the way of Jesus "my food is to do the will of my Father and accomplish his work." (John 4: 34).

The Heart of Jesus is a school of virtues and holiness. He is the path laid out for us by God so that we will not be lost like Adam and Eve or be driven out from the Garden of Eden. Do you desire to love God? Come to Jesus's Heart; Do you want to forgive like Jesus? Come to the Heart of Jesus! Do you want to experience joy like Jesus? Come to the Heart of heaven's joy! Do you desire humility? Come to the ONE who is the place of humility. Do you wish to serve the poor? Come to Jesus, "who came not to be served but to serve and give his life as a ransom for many." (Matthew 20: 28). Are you attracted to serving the children of the community? Seek help from Jesus's Heart who says, "Bring the little ones to me and do not hinder them. For to such as these does the Kingdom of heaven belong." (Matthew 19: 14).

The Heart of Mary belongs to the Holy Spirit because they are ONE. She did not experience physical intercourse in the conception of Jesus but "the Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most high will overshadow you. So the child to be born will be Holy, and He will be called the Son of God." (Luke 1: 35). Her Heart conceives of the Son of God, Jesus Christ. In Her the Word of God actualizes nothing but the Word made flesh. It brought about "what it was meant to achieve." Isaiah 55: 11-12). Only in Mary's Heart did the Word of God produce exactly what God desired: His Only begotten Son, which is the Word of God. If we desire to do exactly God's will, it is important to seek the counsel of Mary. In Her Heart, she is fully disposed and open to receive God's word. Hence she said, "Behold I am the handmaid of the Lord. Be it done to me according to your WORD." (Luke 1: 38). Mary did not oppose God's plan and will like Eve did. If we want to grow in God's will and plan, or mission it is important to learn from Mary . Happy Birthday to the Queen of the Universe!

Baskets, Baskets, and More Baskets!


