

#### From Father Nicholas' desk... Truth and Mercy Series (XXXVIX)

"No disaster can overtake you, no plague come near your tent: he will put you in his angels' charge to guard you wherever you go. They will support you on their hands in case you hurt your foot against a stone." (Psalm 91: 10-12). Amen.

God promised all his children his divine protection with the ministry of his beloved angels and particularly St. Michael the archangel. For me life has not been the same since I took this seriously after my pilgrimage to Italy in May and visited Mount Gargano. This same sight was visited by St. Francis Assisi and his brothers to offer 40 days of prayers and fasting in honor of God and his beloved Mother the Blessed Virgin Mary. The angels are true messengers of God to bring God's graces and fortunes our way. Since the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15, we have prayed together at 8pm daily or other convenient times during the day. It has afforded us all a true spiritual rejuvenation and renewal.

In trying to write this I discovered that Pope Francis on July 5, 2013 consecrated the Vatican City to St. Michael the archangel and St. Joseph. He followed the guide book of St. Pope Leo XIII. At this ceremony Pope-Emeritus Benedict XVI was present. Pope Francis is so aware of the prevailing attack of the evil one in our age and especially in the Vatican City. He has always had the task of reforming the Roman Curia so that it can be of greater service to the Vicar of Christ and the mission of Christ in the world. Listen to the very words of Pope Francis, "We consecrate the Vatican City to St. Michael the archangel, asking him to defend us against evil and to banish it....and to St. Joseph, guardian of Jesus and the guardian of the Holy Family, whose presence strengthens us and gives us the courage to make space for God in our lives in order that good may always vanquish evil."

This weekend as we conclude the St. Michael chaplet and prayers, we will be consecrating ourselves, families and entire parish to the powerful intercession of the great prince of the heavenly host. He will help us against the secularism which is threatening to consume the human race. There is the gender dysphoria and sexual confusion today, the ideological war. The threat against the human family. Our children have never had it so bad. Today families are having to fight government for the right to nurture their children in the faith and values. Satan is not pro-life or pro-God as we have noticed from the very beginning in the book of Genesis. Satan is about death and its culture. Jesus is about life and in abundance (John 10: 10). We need St. Michael's protection against all the violence in the womb, in the city and in our families. We need him to assist us, cleanse our culture of the immodesty, porn culture, and masturbation. We need him to strengthen us against conflict and division in our churches, to nurture a spirit of humility and obedience both at home and in our parishes.

St. Michael ushers us into the Marian Month of October. He is one of the angels ministering to Our Lady and at Her command. St. Michael help us prepare for the reign of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Amen. The 2<sup>nd</sup> month is upon us for the First Friday devotion. Please mark your calendars: October 4 at 4pm. Our powerful Healing Retreat is here as well-Tuesday and Wednesday October 8 and 9 at 5:30pm. We place all our emotional, psychological, physical, generational, and family tree healing in the hands of God through the Masses, praises, worship, adoration during those two days.
