*From Father Nicholas' desk...***Truth and Mercy Series (XXXXI)**

Did you know that it was Pope St. Leo XIII that made October a month dedicated for the praying of the holy rosary? He desired that Our Blessed Mother would be loved more and her holy rosary will be prayed with more fervor and devotion. This was done in 1884, the same year he had a vision of Satan after the celebration of the Holy Mass. Do you know our parish was dedicated for worship during the pontificate of Pope St. Leo XIII? Our present parish church was dedicated to God in 1898 during his reign. It is fitting to make the holy rosary known, loved and prayed. The holy rosary was a special gift to St. Dominic while in the desert after long days of fasting on how to combat the heresy of Albigensianism. It was a heresy that promoted a dualistic view of the world. They claimed that there is a supremacy battle between good and evil. Indeed, they contend that Christ Jesus could not have come in the flesh because, the flesh is basically evil.

Our Blessed Virgin Mary brought the holy rosary as an answer and solution to this error and heresy and indeed all various heresies that came afterwards. The albigensians rallied an army against the catholic army. There was a battle between them. Despite the fact that the Albigensian army were twice the number of the Catholic army, the Catholics won the battle through the praying of the holy rosary. While he had initially preached without success against them, the praying of the holy rosary was very successful. This was not the first and only time the praying of the holy rosary brought victory to the people of God.

In the year 1571 Pope St. Pius V had requested the praying of the holy rosary because of the raging attacks by the Ottoman Empire against the continent of Europe and especially its Christian civilization. Pope St. Pius V attributed the victory in Lepanto to the “arms” of the Rosary than the cannons and valor of the soldiers who fought there. He declared a day in honor of that victory as “Our Lady of Victory” for October 7, 1571. You know our parish is just a stone throw to our sister parish named Our Lady of Victory. In the year 1573, the successor to Pope Pius V, Pope Gregory XIII changed the name of the Feast day to Our Lady of the Holy Rosary.

The monumental victories of Our Lady testifies to the fact that nothing is too big for Her to assist with. She can definitely help us with all our spiritual and material problems like every mother would. She has the Heavenly resources at Her disposal. Her Son Jesus Christ offered all that to Her. In fact, we can safely say it was the entire Blessed Trinity that wished it to be so. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit desires that we receive all we need through the assistance of this Merciful Heavenly Mother. While Jesus died on the Cross, his last will was that we receive Mary as Mother when He said to John the beloved, “Behold your Mother” and to Mary, “Behold your son” (John 19: 26-27). Scripture tells us that since that day John took Mary into his life and into his home. He was not afraid to invite Mary into all that concerns him, his inner life. He entrusted his being and spiritual journey to Her. We are invited to follow John’s example. Mary is so desirous of helping us.

On another note on this day October 9, 1859, Our Heavenly Queen visited the place called Champion. She loves all Her children and always helps us with direction when we are going down a wrong path. She desired that all children in Champion, Wisconsin and the entire world be taught catechism, the way to Heaven. She came to Adele Brise and gave Her this Heavenly message. Mary wants us all to go to Heaven with Her someday. Without the teaching of our faith and knowing how to pray and understand the word of God, it will be impossible. I had in 2022 consecrated all the children in the West End and my parish to Her, requesting Her to help us improve our job of teaching the faith to our children and youth.

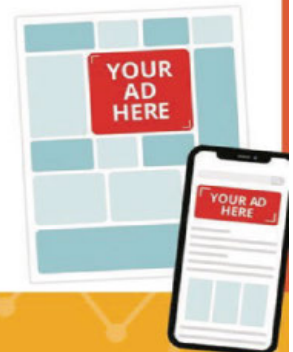

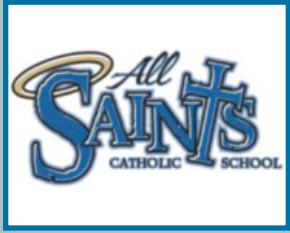
