

From Father Nicholas' desk... Truth and Mercy Series (XXXXV)

A new season is upon us! A beautiful season of expectation. A season of beholding the plan of God wrapped as an infant for us. The season of Advent brings with it so much expectation and joy. It is a season to be jolly and merry. But what is the cause of our merry?

It is because a DIVINE VISITATION is upon us. God desires to be with us not like He has in the past "but now in these final days, he has spoken to us through his Son." (Hebrew 1: 1-2). In the past his form of communication has been partial and incomplete but we are so blessed that nothing compares to Him coming to us through His Son. This is a complete and perfect mode of communication. He does not use any intermediaries at all. Since the Son is the second person of the Blessed Trinity, God Himself comes to us. As John's Gospel tells us, "No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is Himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known." (John 1: 18).

The season of Advent is a celebration of God's immense love for us. He considers us of great dignity that He accords us the visitation of the Divine person, not intermediary. He knows we can find God in creation, in the weather, the snow and rain, the mountains and seas, but in a perfect and clear sense, the presence of the Son shows the connection between God and man in an unmistakable manner. God considers his visit to us in our human form, that means we are of great dignity. God in coming as man shows we are special.

This season calls for us to make every material and spiritual preparation for His coming. The Church has designed ways through which we are to prepare for this august guest. He is the King of our soul and so He desires a pure and holy place to dwell. He invites to the holy sacrament of confession and Holy Mass more fervently during this holy season. He invites us to some moments of reading of scripture to meditate on his saving message for us and savor His love for us. The Church calls on us to deepen our fellowship with Jesus and Mary especially in the praying of the holy rosary.

Make this season HOLY!!
