

PASTORAL COLUMN

Scriptures: Is 50:4-7; Phil 2:6-11; Mk 14:1-15:17

I often wonder about the crowd we read about today. On the first day of the week, they are yelling, "Hosanna to the Son of David." They are waving palms and laying down cloaks in honor of Jesus. By the end of the week, they are turning their backs on Him and yelling, "Crucify Him. Crucify Him." Their negative energy... their frenzy... their mob mentality... plays a huge role in the fact that Jesus is eventually handed over to be crucified. How can this be? Many of the same people who recognize Jesus as a triumphant king help condemn him to death just days later. In reality, each one of us could have been present in *both* of those crowds because we do the same thing in our lives.

It happens when we gather on Sundays in churches around the globe to sing praise to our Creator only to step outside the walls of that church and gossip about one another. It happens when we read Scripture in our homes and yet we can't take the time to listen to one another, to compromise with family members, to say I love you. It happens when we proclaim to live by Christian values but can't find it in ourselves to forgive someone who has hurt us, so we hold on to our anger and our pride. At one and the same time, we cry "Hosanna to the Son of David" and "Crucify Him. Crucify Him."

It happens when we proclaim to believe that all people - of every race, nationality, creed and economic level - are created in the image and likeness of God, and yet we act out of prejudism, racism, sexism, misunderstanding, fear, hatred and revenge. It happens when we declare that, as Christians, we live by an eternal set of standards rather than by society's rules, and yet we place far too much value on possessions, money, prestige and power. It happens when we state that we care very deeply about the poor, and then we fail to consult them, listen to them, or inform ourselves about their concerns and needs. It happens when we proclaim that Christ is in each human being, but we fail to really search for Christ in the faces of those who are different than we are, because we don't take the time to care, to get to know them, to understand them or because we are simply afraid of them. At the same time, we cry "Hosanna to the Son of David" and "Crucify Him. Crucify Him."

It happens when we proclaim to know and love God - a God who is beyond human understanding, but yet we take the liberty of forming God into *our image and likeness*, rather than taking the time to come to know the one true God. It happens when we holy church-goers sometimes don't bring our Christian values and morals into the workplace, where we use aggression, spiteful words, and power to achieve our personal goals. It happens to all of us who are serious about our faith, but can't always find it in us to act with kindness, compassion, forgiveness, mercy and justice. At one and the same time, we cry "Hosanna to the Son of David" and "Crucify Him. Crucify Him."

Yes...each one of us could have been in both of the crowds in Jesus' day. We are broken people made whole by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.


OLL FAITH FORMATION

BROUGHT HERE TOGETHER BY CHRIST'S LOVE, BY LOVE ARE WE THUS BOUND..

During Lent, I've been participating in a national dialogue with Youth Ministers from around the country on *Fratelli Tutti* (written by Pope Francis) and moderated by the National Federation of Catholic Youth Ministers via Zoom. A recent small group I was in had Youth Ministers from NY, TX, MS and WI. One shared a powerful story of desperation and radical hospitality. Catholic Charities in Brownsville, TX, helps refugees when they arrive at the US border with water, a shower, and food. But, most importantly, they welcome them, honor their story, love them without judgment. One young mother told her story. She and her 5-year-old son had walked for three months from Honduras towards the US. She said that she left her home now because, if she had stayed, her son would have been in danger. He would be rounded up by a local drug cartel, forced to work for them, and be dead by age 13. She said it was important for him that they left Honduras now, when he was 5, so that he can live. My counterpart from Texas said that the refugees are so happy to be acknowledged, heard, and welcomed as a child of God. Having a chance to sit, break bread, have her story heard - so powerful and so satisfying. *Fratelli Tutti* means "All Brothers." As the ancient hymn reminds us, "...Brought here together by Christ's love, by love are we thus bound..."
