

## PASTORAL COLUMN

Scriptures: Job 38:1,8-11; 2 Cor 5:14-17; Mk 4:35-41

Today's Gospel is one of my favorites. A wicked storm comes up. The disciples are terrified, but Jesus would have slept right through it had they not woken him. They tell him of their fear and Jesus speaks three simple words: "Quiet! Be still!" The storm ceases and the disciples are filled with awe and peace.

If you are like me, you've been in the disciples' shoes at one time or another. Life is raging in a terrifying storm around us and we feel like God is sleeping. Doesn't God care that we are about to perish? Doesn't God care that we are facing all kinds of tumult around us? Doesn't God care that the wind and waves are threatening to sweep us away?

When I was little, we had a long porch along one side of our house. Often, when there was a storm watch, my dad would line up chairs along the porch, and my siblings and I would sit in the chairs with dad watching the storm build. My dad reasoned, "It's a storm watch, we need to watch for storms." (No worries, when the storm got close, we'd always be ushered inside to safety.) As a result, I have never been afraid of storms. I find there is a sense of excitement and energy that overcomes any dread of destruction that might occur. "Storm watches" taught me that there is much beauty in the storm to go with the possible destruction.

This is true in life as well. Time and time again, I have encountered beauty amidst the tragedy, loss, and ugliness that sometimes comes with living. Countless people have reached out to my family following a variety of tragedies. I have witnessed folks reach out with the finger of God to bring hope and joy to others in the midst of despair and sorrow. I have accompanied others who have repaired or rebuilt homes of those in need after a tragic loss. I know people who have opened their homes to grandchildren, troubled teenagers – even strangers – in need. In countless ways, I have seen kind compassionate people reach out to those who are experiencing the fury of the storms of life.

All of these things have taught me over and over that God is never "sleeping" during the storms of our lives. Perhaps we are looking in the wrong place. In today's world, most of God's ministry takes place through our heart, hands and feet. Wouldn't it be great if we were so good at sharing God's presence that no one ever felt that God was sleeping when they were frightened by the furious storms of life? *Deb Hamm, Pastoral Associate*

Holy Cross Chapel is getting a new roof! The total cost of the project is \$100,250. PHD Roof Doctors, Inc will be performing the work, which includes a complete tear off and replacing it with a new architectural shingle roof system.
