

What is Intercessory Prayer?

Put simply, intercessory prayer is praying for someone else. If your email is in the parish database, you receive prayer requests. These are asking you to intercede on someone else's behalf, to include them in your prayers. These are concerns that someone has called the office and

asked to be put on the "prayer chain." Anyone can do this. If you are not receiving these prayer requests, let the office know so we can get your email into the parish database.

Something that is one of the defining features of our Catholic faith is that we do not limit our requests for intercessory prayer to our families and friends, we also involve the Saints. We believe that the Saints pray for us. Just as we ask our friends here on earth to help us out by praying for us, we ask our spiritual brethren who are already in Heaven to pray for us as well.

Some people have a favorite Saint that they ask for intercession. Some people look to the Saint associated with the topic they are praying about - such as lost objects (St. Anthony), music (St. Cecelia), sports (St. Sebastian), expectant mothers (St. Gerard Majella), or cancer patients (St. Peregrine).

Recently, a student at Mount Pleasant High School was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma. Andrew Rauenbeuhler is a senior and friend to many young people in our parish. This is shocking news, especially for someone so young. Adults and teens alike are asking what we can do to help. Our first step is to bring our concerns for Andrew and his family to prayer. We are interceding on their behalf when we pray for them.

On February 2, 2022 at 6:30pm, we will be gathering in the Church to pray the Rosary for Andrew, turning to our Blessed Mother to ask her to bring our prayers to her son, Jesus.

All are welcome to join us in prayer. If you don't have your own rosary we will have some available. You can also download one of several Catholic apps on your phone that can guide you through the rosary. The Laudate app is free and has a virtual interactive rosary.



WHY DO CATHOLICS DO THAT?

Immaculate Conception

Question:

l'ive heard people call Jesus' conception

by the Holy Spirit being "immaculately conceived." Is that what the Immaculate Conception is?

Answer:

While these two events are often confused, they are not the same thing. We celebrated the conception of Jesus on March 25th, the feast of the Annunciation. While that was surely miraculous, it isn't what we refer to as the "immaculate conception." The Immaculate Conception is Mary's conception, and we typically celebrate it on December 8th. If the 8th happens to be a Sunday, the Church moves the feast to December 9th. It is a holy day of obligation. Why does the Church consider it so important to celebrate?

Mary's conception is immaculate because she was conceived without original sin. The angel Gabriel acknowledges this when he hails Mary as "full of grace" (Luke 1:28). Scripture scholars identify several theological ideas that confirm this. In the Old Testament, the sacred, pristine Ark of the Covenant held the presence of God. The presence of God is now held within a new "arc" — the womb of Mary. Genesis 3 also prophesies of a woman who would oppose the devil and whose child would crush the devil's head. Christ is the "New Adam." This passage sets up Mary, then, as the "New Eve." Jesus and Mary are the beginnings of a new creation, one we all can participate in through the grace of our baptism. After all, God's love is more "original" than our sin! ©LPi

Prophets possess an intimate knowledge of God and act on their experience of God. Prophetic messages usually challenge the

status quo and draw us up and out of ourselves, focusing us on the bigger picture. We often think of ourselves and our own needs first. When we listen to someone speak, we judge the merit of the message by its degree of usefulness. If the message or vision contains no personal benefit or profit but a call to stretch and grow, we can become indignant. Prophets are usually the ones whose message challenges us and calls us to see things differently and love more perfectly and deeply. God is love. When listening to St. Paul speak about love we witness the unfolding of this type of unconditional, other centered, self-sacrificial perfect God. It is an invitation to life, freedom, and happiness that can be offered to us only by God. Jesus, who is God and Love incarnate, calls us to this richer expression of love.
