

# A GOD WITH A MOTHER by Keara Ette Sunday, January 2, 2022

It is nearly impossible to believe: God shrinking down to the size of a zygote, implanted in the soft lining of a woman's womb. God growing fingers and toes. God kicking and hiccuping in utero. God inching down the birth canal and entering this world covered in blood, perhaps into the steady, waiting arms of a midwife. God crying out in hunger. God reaching for his mother's breasts. God totally relaxed, eyes closed, his chubby little arms raised over his head in a posture of complete trust. God resting in his mother's lap.

# Evenings with Encore welcomes Fr. Pat McGrath in January of 2022



Born in Chicago and raised in the south suburbs, Fr. Patrick McGrath, S.J. entered the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) in 2000 and was ordained a priest in 2006. In addition to serving in various roles in Jesuit secondary education for more than 20 years, he is a popular retreat leader and homilist. Fr. McGrath uses storytelling, scripture, wisdom from the Catholic tradition and the spirituality of St. Ignatius Loyola to help others reflect and experience God in all things. Fr. McGrath currently serves as the President of Loyola Academy in Wilmette, Illinois. Founded in 1909, Loyola is the largest Jesuit high school in the United States. Loyola students come from all over the Chicago metropolitan area representing more than 90 different zip codes. The mission of Loyola Academy is to form women and men for meaningful lives of leadership and service in imitation of Jesus Christ through a college preparatory education in the Jesuit, Catholic tradition.

In June 2021, Cardinal Blase Cupich announced that Fr. McGrath will become the next pastor of Old St. Patrick's Church in Chicago starting summer 2022. Fr. McGrath was ordained at Old St. Patrick's (2006) and has served as a weekend presider there ever since. Fr. McGrath holds a B.A. from Notre Dame ('88), a M.Div. from the Jesuit School of Theology and a M.S. from Northwestern. He currently serves on the boards of Loyola Academy and Marquette University.

Fr. Pat McGrath will reflect on the call to be Church through and after a pandemic. He will address the graces and challenges for the days to come as well as where we are called to go as OSP and the Catholic community at large. #### 2/7 Jim Baumann: Good Writing Skill: Not Just Diagramming Sentences



Early in his career as a newspaper editor, Jim Baumann realized that simply correcting someone's writing errors didn't address the problem. To help his staff improve their craft, he initiated quizzes and spelling tests in an educational process that used humor rather than red-lining or lecturing.

Encouraged to expand his audience outside the newsroom, Baumann developed a column, "Grammar Moses", which has become an ongoing conversation with readers. Baumann doesn't consider himself a grammar expert, but rather a hobbyist and enthusiast. Many of these columns have now been incorporated into his book Grammar Moses: A humorous look at grammar and usage.

Baumann, a second-generation suburban journalist, grew up in Arlington Heights and attended Prospect High School. After graduating from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, he joined the Daily Herald as an intern in 1983. He was named managing editor in 2012. After four years as a reporter, he assumed various editing positions for the DuPage and Fox Valley editions. In 2012, he became Managing Editor, and a corporate Vice President in 2016. In November 2021, he was named Executive Editor.

## Grief Support Ministry, HealingTogether@Home

Because we are not meeting in-person for our regular Old St. Pat's Grief Support Group, Companions on the Journey, we have created a grief support group that meets remotely utilizing the Zoom meeting platform. Healing Together@Home has been organized for those who are grieving the death of a loved one: parent, spouse, partner, sibling, family member, friend... It hurts!



You may be experiencing some of the most powerful and painful feelings of your life. The many feelings of grief may seem uncomfortable and threatening to you. And, sadly, there are too few people who want to talk to you about this pain. Support groups provide an opportunity for grieving persons to better understand the wide range of feelings and behaviors associated with grief. More importantly, support groups offer a safe place where people can come together for mutual support, and to learn that their feelings are normal and that one need not be alone.

Our program is offered free of charge over the course of seven consecutive weeks. Our groups are small by design so that they are comfortable and informal. We plan to schedule the next program on Wednesday, January 26th and end on March 16th (with March 2nd excluded due to Ash Wednesday) from 6:30pm to 8:00pm.







# IMMIGRANT AND REFUGEES: A Faith Journey

Sunday, January 2, 2022

In today's first reading the Prophet Isaiah says to "lift up your eyes and look around...your daughters and your sons journey from afar."

Did you know that this displacement of people from their homes is accelerating today? According to UNHCR (the United Nations refugee agency), one person is displaced every three seconds, less than the time it takes to read this sentence. Many become refugees--people who fled not only their homes, but also their countries. Nearly half are children. Many have been terrorized by bombs and gunfire, threatened because of their political or religious beliefs. They are resilient and they endure. While they have been forced to leave possessions behind, they have kept hope.

Hope and your help will sustain them throughout their journeys. Many refugees spend years in camps or temporary homes. # Saint Basil the Great Saint of the Day for January 2

Basil was on his way to becoming a famous teacher when he decided to begin a religious life of gospel poverty. After studying various modes of religious life, he founded what was probably the first monastery in Asia Minor. He is to monks of the East what Saint Benedict is to the West, and Basil's principles influence Eastern monasticism today.

He was ordained a priest, assisted the archbishop of Caesarea—now southeastern Turkey—and ultimately became archbishop himself, in spite of opposition from some of the bishops under him, probably because they foresaw coming reforms.

Arianism, one of the most damaging heresies in the history of the Church which denied the divinity of Christ, was at its height. Emperor Valens persecuted orthodox believers, and put great pressure on Basil to remain silent and admit the heretics to communion. Basil remained firm, and Valens backed down. But trouble remained. When the great Saint Athanasius died, the mantle of defender of the faith against Arianism fell upon Basil. He strove mightily to unite and rally his fellow Catholics who were crushed by tyranny and torn by internal dissension. He was misunderstood, misrepresented, accused of heresy and ambition. Even appeals to the pope brought no response. "For my sins I seem to be unsuccessful in everything."

Basil was tireless in pastoral care. He preached twice a day to huge crowds, built a hospital that was called a wonder of the world—as a youth he had organized famine relief and worked in a soup kitchen himself—and fought the prostitution business.

Basil was best known as an orator. Though not recognized greatly in his lifetime, his writings rightly place him among the great teachers of the Church. Seventy-two years after his death, the Council of Chalcedon described him as "the great Basil, minister of grace who has expounded the truth to the whole earth."


