

A REFLECTION AS WE LOOK AHEAD TO JUNETEENTH

Juneteenth (June 19) is our newest national holiday. It originated in 1865 when Union General Granger declared that all enslaved people in Texas were now truly free. Juneteenth commemorates and celebrates the struggles of African Americans to help America live up to its creed: we are all are created equal and endowed by God with inalienable rights. Ignoring or forgetting these truths will destroy us as a nation.

So said James Baldwin. In December 1986, he addressed the prestigious National Press Club in Washington. He had been speaking and writing about racism for nearly fifty years. Now he was going to discuss it with this elite and influential audience.

Our country was in trouble, he said. The crimes of the past have made us in great part what we are now: for example, stealing lands from indigenous peoples; killing as many of them as possible; buying, selling, and breeding kidnapped Africans; maintaining a brutal slave system and white domination by fraud and violence. Yet America prefers sincerity over the truth. America wants to be simple-minded when the world is complex.

No country is innocent, but it is one thing to commit crimes and another thing to deny them. Denial requires that fantasies of innocence must be invented and defended. For instance, "happy slaves" were needed because otherwise their "owners" would have to admit that slavery was truly evil. Even now too many whites see only the black person they want to see, not someone just as fully human as themselves. Their blindness weaves bitter conflicts into our social fabric.

The discussion that followed did not go well. Baldwin realized that this elite, supposedly well-informed white audience also believed the American illusions that he had just described. So he tried once more to get through to them.

No, we're talking about the life and death of this country! . . . I'm not joking when I talk about [establishing] white history week. One of the things that affects this country is that white people don't know who they are or where they come from. That's why you think I'm a problem! But I am not the problem! Your history is! And as long as you pretend you don't know your history, you're going to be the prisoner of it.

And there is no question of your liberating me because you can't liberate yourselves. We're in this together. . . I want to grow up and so should you!

The May 14 killings in Buffalo are only the latest of recurring anti-black violence. They show us – again! – the price of ignoring the past that shapes our present. Embracing Juneteenth can teach us the history we need to survive as one nation - and, more importantly, to live our Christian faith authentically.


Watch for the IRM table on World Refugee Day outside some OSP Masses on Sunday, 6/26



Blessed Jolenta of Poland Saint of the Day for June 12, 2022

Jolenta was the daughter of Bela IV, King of Hungary. Her sister, St. Kunigunde, was married to the Duke of Poland. Jolenta was sent to Poland where her sister was to supervise her education. Eventually married to Boleslaus, the Duke of Greater Poland, Jolenta was able to use her material means to assist the poor, the sick, widows, and orphans. Her husband joined her in building hospitals, convents, and churches so that he was surnamed "the Pious."

Upon the death of her husband and the marriage of two of her daughters, Jolenta and her third daughter entered the convent of the Poor Clares. War forced Jolenta to move to another convent where despite her reluctance, she was made abbess

So well did Jolenta serve her Franciscan sisters by word and example, that her fame and good works continued to spread beyond the walls of the cloister. Her favorite devotion was the Passion of Christ. Indeed, Jesus appeared to her, telling her of her coming death. Many miracles, down to our own day, are said to have occurred at her grave.






