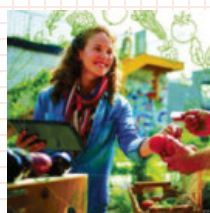

SAVE THE DATE

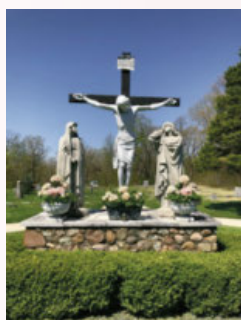

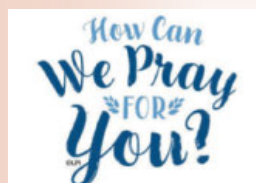
