VOCATIONS CORNER

World Priest Day- Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus
Friday June 24, 2022



The World Priest Day celebration was established by Pope John Paul II in 2002 to encourage priests to reflect upon the importance and dignity of the gift of priesthood they have received from Christ. In conjunction with World Priest Day; the question "What advice would you give to someone who is just beginning discernment" was asked of our three June religious ordination celebrants.

In the 1st reading at the June 10 daily Mass, we heard about Elijah in a cave encountering God not in a strong wind, in an earthquake or in fire, but in a "tiny whispering sound." It is important to create a silent place of prayer in the presence of the Lord where this tiny whispering sound can be heard on a regular basis. Also, young people often recognize the tiny whispering sound while they are involved in some type of service in their parish or community. Our acts of service can help us hear God's subtle call." **Bishop Thomas Zinkula**, June 22, 2022

"Parents and Grandparents should encourage vocations, and pray for the sense of calling. In addition to prayer, offer sacrifices and fasting for the vocation intention. As my sister encouraged me, when I was doubting going into the Seminary, "If you don't try you won't know." **Father Joseph Phung**, June 24, 2022

"I think, first one must be in a state of grace, totally in love with our Creator. Second is to PRAY for an open mind and heart, that the Holy Spirit give one the wisdom to properly understand what it is that one feels called to. NOT MY WILL BUT YOUR WILL BE DONE IN ME!!! A GOOD Spiritual director would be very helpful. Read the bible, lives of the Saints and writings of the great men and women who have influenced the Church for encouragement and direction for starters." **Deacon Gengenbacher**, June 27, 2022

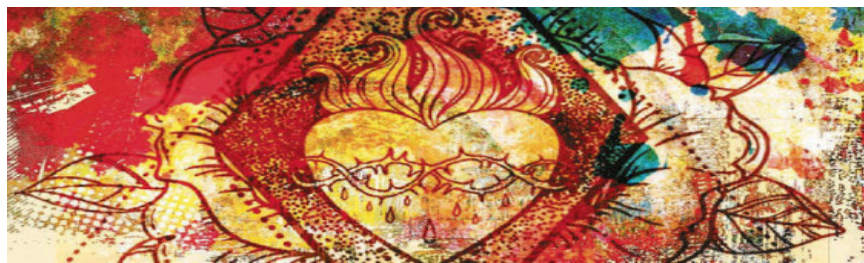

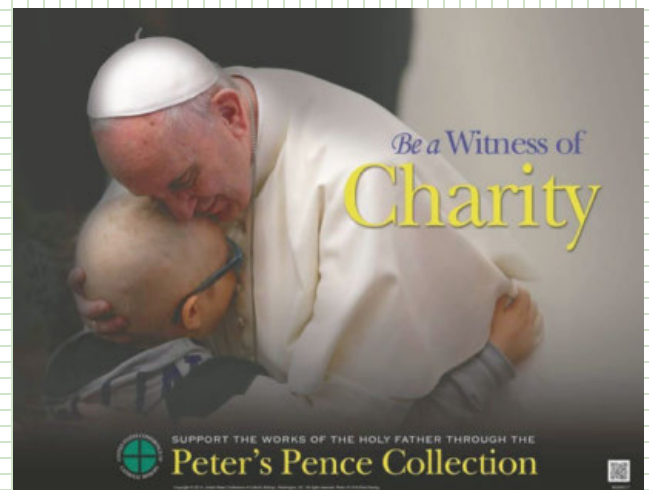
