VOCATIONS CORNER

In recognition of the Davenport Diocese's **Permanent Deacon Ordinations** this weekend, some frequently asked questions regarding the vocation of the diaconate are below.

Who is a Permanent Deacon?

A permanent deacon is an ordained minister of the Catholic Church. Deacons are ordained as a sacramental sign to the Church and to the world of Christ, who came "to serve and not to be served." They do not go on to become priests.

What are the "various ministries" of the Permanent Deacon?

All ordained ministers in the Church are called to functions of Word, Sacrament, and Charity. As ministers of Word, permanent deacons proclaim the Gospel, preach, and teach in the name of the Church. As ministers of Sacrament, deacons baptize, lead the faithful in prayer, witness marriages, and conduct wake and funeral services. As ministers of Charity, deacons are leaders in identifying the needs of others, then marshaling the Church's resources to meet those needs.

May married men be ordained permanent deacons?

Yes. The Second Vatican Council decreed that the diaconate, when it was restored as a permanent order in the hierarchy, could be opened to "mature married men" later clarified to mean men over the age of 35. This is in keeping with the ancient tradition of the Church, in which married men were ordained into ministry.

Is a Permanent Deacon ordained for the Parish or the Diocese?

Whenever a person is ordained, he is to serve the diocesan Church. Permanent Deacons are no different in this regard: they are assigned by the bishop to ministries for which the bishop perceives a great need, and for which the deacon may have special gifts or talents. Most often, this will be within a parish setting, just as most priests serve in a parish. Once assigned to the parish, the deacon and any other clergy assigned to the parish minister under the immediate supervision of the pastor. Let us pray the for the newly ordained permanent deacons and for our Holy Family Parish deacons and their wives.

Make their hearts like yours so they may love your people.



Save September 24 & 25, 2022 to attend the seventh life-changing Christ Our Life Conference. Once again, world-class speakers will present topics of critical importance to all.






