



Christian Formation



Dear Friends in Christ,

This week's reflection from the archdiocesan document. The Gift of Sunday, is the fifth and final session, titled: "The Day of Justice".

I have to admit, this session was the most difficult for me personally to decipher the message

and intent of the title. When I first started reading it, I had a mental impression from the title of what I thought the session would convey, but I wasn't even close.

So as I read and re-read and puzzled over the author's intent, I began to focus on the word "Justice". Perhaps having a true sense of how justice is defined would help me digest the session. The common definitions of justice in dictionaries seemed too simplistic and had little or no spiritual context. So, I decided to consult the Cathechism of the Catholic Church.

"Justice is the moral virtue that consists in the constant and firm will to give their due to God and neighbor. Justice toward God is called the 'virtue of religion.' Justice toward men disposes one to respect the rights of each and to establish in human relationships the harmony that promotes equity with regard to persons and to the common good..." CCC 1807

We are reminded once again that our celebration of Eucharist challenges us to lay down our lives for others as a pleasing sacrifice to God, just as Jesus laid down His life for all in dying and rising: "Do this in memory of me." And so I leave you with the lyrics of a hymn that the choir at St. Agnes used to sing on Holy Thursday.


Last session we were brought face to face with the abandonment

"But my people did not listen to my voice ... So I gave them over to their stub-


bornhearts, to follow their own counsels. O that my people my hand against their foes" (Psalm 81:11-14).






