

Christian Formation News

Dear Friends in Christ.

This weekend's Feast of the Epiphany has a common thread running through the Scripture readings: light, light, and more light! In Isaiah, the prophet proclaims: "... Your light has come,..."; in St. Paul's letter to the Ephesians, he refers to his experience of the "... mystery made known to me by revelation...", which we all recall involved his being blinded by a bright light; and the Gospel story features the wise men being led by the light of the star...



In fact, as I did some research into the meaning and etymology of the word **Epiphany**, its linguistic roots could be interpreted as "to shine upon". Indeed, the fundamental reality of light is so essential to our very existence and being that we can't imagine life without it. The inferences and implications for every aspect of life are limitless.

I believe that is why St. Paul, even with his extremely personal and intimate encounter with the risen Lord, talks about the *mystery* of revelation. We can only begin to sense a glint of God shining His light upon us, but even that

glint, in the person of Jesus, the Word made Flesh, the Christ, Incarnate for a short thirty year span in the eternity of salvation history, illuminates everything!



Training dates for **Level 1 Part B** will be offered one Saturday a month, Sept. 2022 - March 2023:


• Sept. 17, Oct.8, Nov. 12, Dec. 10 and in 2023, Jan.14, Feb. 11, & March 11.

Lori Prescott, Executive Director of Family Promise of Washington County, expressed her appreciation and stated the gift cards will be distributed to the residents and staff of Karl's Place to spend on Christmas gifts as well as homeless persons on the shelter waiting list staying in motels for gifts and daily essentials.

The 14 beds at Karl's Place have been fully occupied since the shelter for homeless single men and women opened in February 2018 with a constant waiting list that is at its highest number at this time. From January through November 2021, 56 homeless persons have been served with 4,014 nights of shelter provided at Karl's Place.




