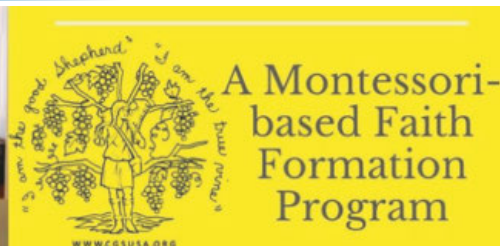
Today's question: **What is prayer?**...In the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the first response to that question is subtitled "Prayer as God's gift", and is beautifully described in the following reference to the Woman at the Well story from John's Gospel. "The wonder of prayer is revealed beside the well where we come seeking water: there, Christ comes to meet every human being. It is he who first seeks us and asks us for a drink. Jesus thirsts: his asking arises from the depths of God's desire for us. Whether we realize it or not, prayer is the encounter of God's thirst with ours. God thirsts that we may thirst for him." 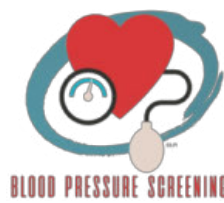
