


Our first graders did a marvelous job creating 'Bag Buddies'! They had to make a paper bag "puppet' of a character from a book they read. Great Job, Kids!

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

In my article this week I conclude a series of reflections on prayer which I began before Christmas, anticipating the <u>OREMUS</u> ("Let us pray") small group series to begin prior to Lent 2022. Stay tuned in the weeks ahead for more details about this upcoming opportunity. In my previous two articles, we reflected on the questions *Would you like to hear God speak* to you? and "Where does prayer come from?



Today's question: **What is prayer?**...In the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the first response to that question is subtitled "Prayer as God's gift", and is beautifully described in the following refer-

ence to the Woman at the Well story from John's Gospel. "The wonder of prayer is revealed beside the well where we come seeking water: there, Christ comes to meet every human being. It is he who first seeks us and asks us for a drink. Jesus thirsts: his asking arises from the depths of God's desire for us. Whether we realize it or not, prayer is the encounter of God's thirst with ours. God thirsts that we may thirst for him." (CCC 2560)
