Is it truly possible to *possess* Christ's glory???!!! When I started to reflect on this bold statement, I was incredulous. How is it possible that we frail human creatures can possess the glory of God? But the more I pondered that question, I realized that God has shared His glory and continues to share His glory with us in more ways than we can number.

In truth, as the poet Gerard Manley Hopkins expressed: "The world is charged with the grandeur of God."


