St. John's Christian Women

All ladies of the parish are Christian Women. What we do is cook, prepare and serve funeral meals. The ladies donate desserts and salads. We prepare and serve homeless meals for St. John the Evangelist Homeless Shelter and NEW Community Homeless Shelter. There are men who help us with funeral and homeless meals. Because of covid, we did not have our parish breakfast on the first Sunday of May and our Saturday pot luck supper with silent auction in the fall with proceeds going to our local St. Vincent de Paul. We have bake sales for benefits and the money goes to the family. We donate the chicken and mixed vegetables for Fat Sunday. We do reception for leaving and coming pastors. The money we receive is from funerals. Sometimes we will receive a donation from a parish family. We donate money to Brother Regis, Community 2000, local St. Vincent de Paul and Mothers of Unborn Baby Care plus diaper etc. We have purchased dishes, coffee pots, stoves, refrigerators, kettles, pots, baking dishes, silverware, nesco, tables, chairs, paper plates, cups, napkins and other replacements for the kitchen. On Sunday, June 5 at the 10 am mass Fr. Dass will present us with a certificate for 100 years of service. **After mass we will have a social in the school for the parish which will be desserts and beverages. All are welcome.**

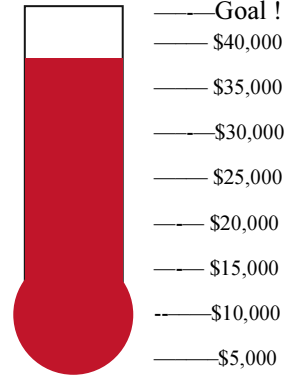

Why Do We Do That? Catholic Life Explained - Deacons

Question: At a parish council meeting, our pastor mentioned the need for deacons. It is something I am considering. How do I know if I have a vocation? What steps should I take next?

Answer: Any and all gifts that the Holy Spirit gives to the church are for the good of the community. As members of the Body of Christ, what one member does affects all. What the body does also affects each member. A vocation or call to ministry is tested and verified by the church. Through prayer, instruction, and service, a vocation is tested, and then acknowledged by the official call to orders or to service. If you are considering becoming a deacon, the first step would be to talk to your pastor. He will be able to give you more specific information on the program in your diocese, what is expected of you, and how you apply. You might also begin to see a spiritual director, someone who can help you with your faith journey and vocation discernment. They do so by focusing on prayer, your relationship with God, and spiritual practices. Finally, you'll need to see the diocesan vocation director in charge of deacons to apply. Best wishes!

Living the Liturgy - We all have our ideas of who God is. We have to remember, however, that our ideas of God often do not capture who God really is. God is a wonderful mystery whose identity is inexhaustible. This makes life an exciting journey in search of belief, love, glory, and unity. Displaying all of the tenderness of a real love story, we hear from Jesus that God wants nothing more than for the world to believe. The same depth of affection given to Jesus, God the Father desires to share with us. Receiving this love gives the believer an even greater understanding of what gives us purpose and meaning. With God's unconditional love as our anchor, we can endure the greatest of hardships knowing that we carry the hope of glory within us. Sharing in the same incredible eternal destiny and glory that God gave His Son, we can all be one just as Jesus and the Father are one. Why is understanding all of this important? Because given the myriad choices of what can possibly define us, we now have the primordial truth of who we are given to us by God. We know, beyond doubt, where to look for true happiness and where our lives will end.

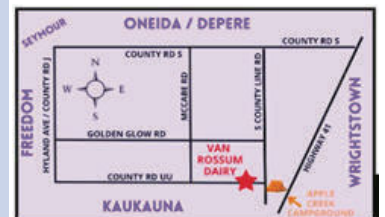
