
Anointing of the Sick

For Spiritual Growth

"I am the bread of Life." I have always enjoyed trips to the grocery store in the afternoon when families are shopping. The little ones are often following after their mothers begging to buy some sort of sweat or food that is probably not that good for them. As the cart continues to fill with things like vegetables and healthy cereals and milk I can see the child getting more and more concerned that what they really want will never be fulfilled. As simple of a dilemma as not getting Oreos can be those children are afraid. We find ourselves often afraid of not getting the things we believe we truly need. This fear drives us to acquire whatever it is that will fill us. This same fear is what drove the crowds from our Gospel story from last weekend to follow after Christ. They were looking for Christ to fulfill their desire to fill their bellies and yet God's desire is much for fulfilling. How often do we look to God for certain wants, certain needs hoping that He will fulfill them and yet God answers our prayers with a much more fulfilling response, HIMSELF.

"Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled. Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him the Father, God, has set his seal."
