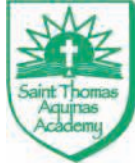

BOILER FUND CAMPAIGN AT ST. MARY

Beginning this weekend, the second collection during the first weekend of the month will be a boiler maintenance collection. We had an unexpected repair cost of approximately \$10,000 that needed to be completed immediately in order to be able to heat the church and school this winter.

We would have considered moving forward with the full replacement of the boiler but the timeline was too short to complete the project before this winter. The good news is that we feel this repair could extend the life of the boiler longer than we originally anticipated. We are over 25% toward our goal of \$90,000 for the replacement of our boiler and we will continue the Boiler Replacement Fund Campaign.

We would like to thank our parishioners for their continued generous support of the Boiler Replacement Campaign as well as the short term boiler maintenance collection to help pay for the costly repair.
