### FROM FATHER CARLOS



Dear Friends:

On Tuesday, September 14 in the morning, I had the opportunity to attend one of Father Nathan's talks on How to Respond to Gender Ideology. I found the presentation very helpful and necessary for our times. The presentation included concepts that are fundamental to our understanding of God, the human person and the world, some of which I

echo in this column.

First, the concept of Christian anthropology as "the right way to think about the person in light of Jesus Christ." One of the II Vatican Council's Constitutions, Gaudium et Spes, states that "Christ, the final Adam, by the revelation of the mystery of the Father and His love, fully reveals man to man himself and makes his supreme calling clear" (22.) In the Gospel, the Lord Jesus goes back to the fundamental truth that "from the beginning, the Creator 'made them male and female'"(Matthew 19:4.) It is thus that the Lord affirms the foundational principle that "being man' and 'being woman' is a reality which is good and willed by God."

God also created us free. In our current culture, there is a misunderstanding of freedom that affects our view of the human person and the full living out of its vocation as sons and daughters of God. As Father Nathan pointed out, freedom is not the right to do whatever I will but instead, freedom is the "possibility, the capacity to do what is right," echoing thus the teachings of the Church on Freedom found in Church documents such as Veritatis Splendor, an encyclical letter written by Pope Saint John Paul II in 1993.

And, how do we know what the right thing to do is? In order to answer this question, it is necessary to understand the proper end for which the human person was created as Father Nathan also pointed out in his talk. The human person was created for God. God is man's ultimate end as Saint Augustine beautifully explains when he says, "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You." The right thing for someone to do, therefore, will always be that which is conducive to the achievement of man's proper end, the vision of God, following the plan God has himself devised for and revealed to us so that we "may have life" (John 10:10.)

Since "the human person, created in the image of God, is a being at once corporeal and spiritual," our end or purpose is also "natural, biological and spiritual" as Father Nathan explained. At the heart of the gender ideology discourse is also the divide between mind and body in such a way that "the mind does not see what the body makes plain," leading the person to stray from God's plan and the consequent achievement of happiness for which the human person was created. As Father Nathan wrote, "one is only going to truly achieve interior peace, joy, and freedom when one accepts the non-negotiable biological, social, and spiritual guardrails/limits of the reality of 'male and female he created them'."
