

Dear Brothers and Sisters.

A number of people have asked me about Pope Francis' recent letter "Guardians of the Tradition." The letter addresses the permission that was granted to priests to celebrate the "Tridentine" Mass, i.e., to celebrate Mass in the manner prior to the reforms of the Second Vatican Council.

After consultation with the bishops of the world and the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, he states that, in his desire for unity and concord within the Church, he establishes by means of the letter that, "The liturgical books promulgated by Saint Paul VI and Saint John Paul II, in conformity with the decrees of Vatican Council II, are the unique expression of the *lex orandi* of the Roman Rite." The Latin phrase means "the law, (or rule) of prayer". Simply stated, the liturgical books promoted by these two saints are to be considered normative, and their validity and legitimacy are not to be called into question.

With regard to the celebration of Mass in Latin, he leaves it to each diocesan bishop to grant permission.

The following is from Bishop Hicks regarding the letter:

On July 16, 2021, Pope Francis' issued an Apostolic Letter, Traditionis Custodes ("Guardians of the Tradition."). His letter gives directions about the use of the liturgical forms prior to the reforms of 1970 (commonly known as the "Vetus Ordo" or "Latin Mass"). Because the Holy Father is entrusting the implementation of his directives to local diocesan bishops, it is necessary that I address the implications of this letter for the Diocese of Joliet.

It is clear from the Holy Father's letter that he intends for each diocesan bishop, "as moderator, promoter, and guardian of the whole liturgical life of the particular Church," to apply careful and diligent consideration regarding the celebration of the Latin Mass in his diocese. I take that charge seriously, and plan to review, study and reflect upon this issue. Also, in the coming weeks, I will seek the input and advice of others including the College of Consultors and the Presbyteral Council.

Once I have reached my conclusions regarding the local implications and implementations of the Holy Father's Apostolic Letter, I will issue a decree to that effect. In the meanwhile, current practices with regard to the 1962 Missal remain in place.

As always, I hope for unity of the Church in communion with the Holy Father. I thank you for your patience and ask for your prayers during this deliberation.
