FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Brothers and Sisters,


Alleluia! Jesus Christ is risen today! The joy of the Easter season, for a Christian, is not a mere pious sentiment, nor a vague optimism that somehow things will turn out well in the end. Rather, the very core of our identity as Christians is an abiding hope that is founded on the surest possible grounds: the Word of God Himself! This Word assumed our human weakness, in order to permit Him to do what He could not do as

God, namely, suffer and die. Thankfully, the story does not end with Good Friday. Rather, it is the empty tomb of Easter Sunday that gives us the confidence that, one day, our own graves will be empty! And so, no matter how difficult the burdens of this present life may be, they are temporary burdens that are the prelude to a joy that knows no bounds. This is our hope, and this is the cause of our joy.

There is a difference between optimism and hope. According to Pope Francis,

"Optimism is a psychological attitude, while hope is a gift of God, a virtue that God puts in your heart that is rooted in his promise not to let you lose your way. This is the hope of that anchor that is thrown to the shore in the fullness of time, and we hold onto the rope of this anchor so that we don't lose our way in the midst of the various hopeless, pessimistic, or simply neutral proposals that life places in our heart—which, in the end, do not satisfy us but leave us sad, as those who are just drifting along. Grasping this cable of hope, remembering what Jesus promised us, let us go forward, recalling what the angel has told us: "Do not seek the living among the dead."

May this Easter season remind us of the reason for our hope and the cause of our joy: Jesus Christ is risen today!
