# Fr. Dan Hoehn — from the pastor's desk



Today is Good Shepherd Sunday, and Jesus reveals himself as the gate through which he leads us to eternal life.


We know that the Good Shepherd had to lay down his life in order to open that gate. And therein lies the mystery. Jesus *himself* thought we were worth dying for! And as great as the difference between a man and his sheep is, how much greater is the difference between a creature and his Creator!

I find myself often repeating the question asked by the psalmist: "What is man that you are mindful of him, mere mortals that you care for them?" Could it be that Jesus was mistaken? After all, people who are in love do crazy things for their beloved! Could it be that in his great love for us, he has overestimated our worth? Again, we are confronted with the unthinkable! God cannot be wrong! God cannot over (or under) -estimate! The bottom line has to be the inescapable conclusion that if he laid down his life for you, there must be something about you that you will never be able to grasp in this life – and maybe not even in the next; something that only God can see!

Is that not comforting to know when you begin to be burdened by your sinfulness – that despair can never be the response of a Christian, because of our knowledge of our incomprehensible dignity and worth? The Good Shepherd who knows us, of course, has not left us alone, even though he has laid down his life. He continues to guide us, as he promised the Apostles: "Whoever hears you, hears me." He told Peter, "Feed my sheep," and Peter and his successors have continued to do that down through the ages. Do we recognize his voice? Do we have difficulty putting our faith in the shepherds who have guided the Church century after century?

If you are having a hard time hearing his voice, here is some advice from Pope St. Gregory the Great: "Ask yourselves whether you belong to his flock, whether you know him, whether the light of his truth shines in your minds. I assure you that it is not *by faith* that you will come to know him, but *by love*; not by mere conviction, but by *action*. John the evangelist is my authority for this statement. He tells us that 'anyone who claims to know God without keeping his commandments is a liar." Only by imitating the love of the Good Shepherd will we ever come to know him.

May our acts of love help us to recognize the voice of the Good Shepherd who has laid down his life for us.
